

FROM THE PASTOR



As the day was drawing to a close, the Twelve approached Jesus and said, "Dismiss the crowd so that they can go to the surrounding villages and farms and find lodging and provisions; for we are in a deserted place here." He said to them, "Give them some food yourselves." Before the Lord was taken up into heaven, He made a promise to His disciples. He said, "I will be with you till the end of time." Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ; that is, the Eucharist, the manner in which our Lord keeps His promise...till the end of time. I will be with you till the end of time. I'm confident that when Christ said these words, He didn't say them to give His men a false sense of security. No. He said them because He meant them; and His Apostles breathed a great sigh of relief. But how would He do it? How would the Lord make himself physically present? Answer: Through the Eucharist. Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you have no life in you. In no way, shape or form did the Lord intend for us to take His (these) words as "symbolically" or "metaphorically" true. No. He meant what He said. In fact, He repeated Himself three times: "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day. For my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in them" (John 6:54-56). It is more than obvious what Christ meant. It's ridiculously clear what He meant! The Lord wants us to take His word as they are: literally, objectively, and physically (the Word became flesh) true. Christ will be with us literally, objectively, and physically. Now let's not forget something, please. Let's not forget that the Jews were surrounded by pagan religions, and that they were constantly purifying themselves and their religion from any foreign ideas or idols. It wasn't easy work, for they were surrounded by the most disgusting people in the world who had some of the craziest religious practices that included such things as cannibalism and vampirism (Yes, vampirism! And well before it was made fashionable by movies such as "Twilight")! The Lord would never have spoken these words to His audience to intentionally mislead them. Nor would He have put His very own Apostles to the test by repeatedly using confusing pagan concepts! No! Not at all! God tells the truth. It is the devil that distorts the truth. Cannibalism, vampirism, and human sacrifices from the valley of Gehenna in Canaan are distortions of God's loving plan for us! The priests of the order of Melchizedek were a beautiful preparation for the arrival of Moses and the Pascal meal, which was the final preparation for the Lord's Supper, where bread and wine would turn into the Body and Blood of the Lamb of God. How do you worship Him? Once upon a time, and in the desert, the Jews began to worship God their own way. The Lord was not pleased with them. So, He instructed them as to how they should worship Him. Jesus instructed His Apostles how they should worship Him: "Take this all of you and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my blood, the blood of the new and eternal covenant...Do this in memory of me." Do this in memory of me. How often do I hear people tell me that the Church is too ritualistic? Well, I hate to break it to them, but the truth is: the Church isn't any more ritualistic than they are! Almost everything we do is ritualistic. From the time we wake up to the time we go to bed, how we brush our teeth, take a shower, put on our clothes and the times we eat are a ritual! Let's be honest. We want to worship God "our way," which is another way of saying, "I want to worship God in a way that makes me feel good. Who cares about how God feels?" The only thing God feels is pity for us. Corpus Christi is not a scandal of faith; it is the rock of our faith! Many disciples returned to their former way of life when they heard these hard sayings from the Lord. Give them some food yourselves. We think we can solve the world's problems. We can't. But unfortunately, we keep overselling ourselves and under delivering to others. All we have are "five loaves" and "two fish." What good is that? Well maybe it's a good start. Yes. But it's hardly enough to put a dent into the world's problems. Only the Lord can give us what we truly desire: His presence in the world and food that will never perish. Do you want to leave too? Many did. Many have. So let us keep in our minds and hearts Peter's response to that very question: "Lord, where are we to go? Only you have the words of eternal life" (John 6:68). Amen to that!



Mot de notre Aumônier

Bien aimés frères et sœurs, chers amis,


Après avoir célébré la Pentecôte et la Sainte Trinité, l'Eglise en ce dimanche vénère et adore dans la liturgie le trésor légué par Jésus lui-même, c'est-à-dire : lui-même. Lui-même sous la forme du Pain et du Vin consacrés qui sont devenus au cours de la messe, le Corps et le Sang du Christ. Chez ceux qui n'ont pas la foi, on peut se dire : qu'est-ce que c'est que ce rite bizarre où les chrétiens vont manger un bout de pain et disent que c'est le Corps de Jésus ? Chez ceux qui sont protestants, on se dit que ce rite rappelle le fait que Jésus a donné son corps et son sang pour nous ; c'est un mémorial, un rite qui nous aide à faire mémoire de... Mais chez les catholiques, on reconnaît et on croit que ce bout de pain EST le Corps du Christ, parce que c'est Jésus lui-même qui au soir du Jeudi Saint a institué ce rite devant des disciples qui ne comprenaient alors pas grand-chose, si ce n'est que ça allait mal finir pour Lui... Le fait que nous commémorions ce don institué et légué par Jésus ne nous met pas à l'abri des questions ou des doutes qu'il suscite. Bien au contraire ! Alors que St Jean nous rapporte dans l'Evangile ce que Jésus est en train d'instituer, sa présence dans le Pain et le Vin, St Jean n'oublie pas de nous rapporter les doutes des auditeurs de Jésus, voire même les oppositions. Nous savons que beaucoup de disciples vont quitter Jésus après ce discours. Beaucoup ne vont pas comprendre et vont en rester à un sens littéral : cet homme veut nous donner sa chair à manger et son sang à boire... mais, nous en sommes pas cannibales ! Bien sûr, ces paroles que Jésus prononce ne sont pas à comprendre au premier sens, mais elles sont à comprendre à travers le rite qu'il institue. Et Jésus sera clair ; Il ne dira pas : ce pain représentera mon corps ; ce vin représentera mon sang. Il dira : « Le pain que je donnerai, c'est ma chair, donnée pour que le monde ait la vie. » Ce mystère de la transsubstantiation est certes difficile à croire, mais c'est l'objet de notre foi et objet d'un acte de foi de notre part. Ce qu'on ne peut comprendre et voir, notre foi ose l'affirmer hors des Lois de la nature. Ce mystère comporte plusieurs effets. Je vais en énumérer juste trois : Le premier, c'est que le Saint-Sacrement, la Présence de Jésus dans le Pain consacré, nourrit notre vie divine. Si Jésus a choisi de se donner à nous sous l'espèce du pain, c'est bien pour nous montrer qu'il se fait nourriture. Le deuxième effet de ce mystère, c'est que le Saint Sacrement permet à Dieu de demeurer en nous, comme nous en Dieu. Jésus le dit lui-même dans ses paroles : Celui qui mange ma chair et boit mon sang demeure en moi et moi, je demeure en lui. » Il ne peut y avoir de communion plus grande, plus parfaite et plus totale entre Dieu et nous que dans le Pain consacré. A travers la Communion, Dieu vient habiter réellement en nous, physiquement. Enfin le troisième effet de ce mystère, c'est que l'Eucharistie fait de nous le Corps du Christ. Puisque nous communions au même Pain, nous avons part au même Corps, et nous devenons ce même Corps. C'est l'Eucharistie qui façonne, construit et solidifie l'Eglise par l'incorporation des fidèles qui communient au Corps du Christ Ressuscité. Le Saint-Sacrement fait l'Eglise et fait notre unité. Le Saint-Sacrement est le médicament contre la division, les ruptures et tout ce qui blesse et détruit notre unité et notre communion. Frères et sœurs, en ce jour bénî où **nous adorons Jésus lui-même**, confions-lui chacune de nos vies et nos familles au centre desquelles le chef demeure le PERE, le PAPA. Aujourd'hui, fête des pères, BONNE FETE A TOUS LES PAPAS. Que Dieu vous bénisse et vous fortifie au quotidien. Confions aussi à Jésus l'unité de notre famille de l'Aumônerie ainsi que celle de notre Eglise. Bonne fête de la SAINTE TRINITE et sanctifiante journée dominicale à toutes et à tous !

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO



Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

Primera Lectura:

Génesis 14:18-20

Hoy celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Fue el Papa Urbano IV que instituyó la festividad del Corpus Christi en el año 1264. Desde entonces hasta nuestros días, la Iglesia con gran fervor celebra junto con sus fieles esta Solemnidad. “La fiesta de Corpus Christi nos pide convertirnos a la fe en la Providencia, saber compartir lo poco que somos y tenemos y no cerrarnos nunca en nosotros mismos. La Eucaristía es el memorial del amor de Dios. Ahí se celebra el memorial de la pasión, del amor de Dios por nosotros, que es nuestra fuerza, el apoyo para nuestro caminar”... El Señor, no se olvida de nosotros y cada vez que vamos a él nos conforta con amor” (Papa Francisco).

¿Qué tal está el amor a la Eucaristía en mí? ¿Cuándo comulgo, lo hago con respeto y agradecimiento? La Eucaristía es un pan para sobrevivir, para ayudar al más necesitado. Las palabras de Jesús en el Evangelio tienen mucho de este compromiso de compartir. “Denles ustedes mismos de comer” (Lucas 9:11). Sentimiento de solidaridad en nosotros, los seguidores de Jesús. Forma parte de la esencia de la fe, tanto en la sociedad como en la comunidad. Y, el Evangelio nos dice: “Todos comieron hasta saciarse. Después se recogieron los pedazos que habían sobrado, y llenaron doce canastos (Lucas 9:17). Aquí, el asunto es, que no se puede comulgar el Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo y seguir como si nada, viviendo egoístamente para uno mismo. Comulgar, es darse uno todo a los demás, ya sea en la familia, en el trabajo o en la universidad ©LPI






