

FROM THE PASTOR



When the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled, he resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem...On the way they entered a Samaritan village to prepare for his reception there, but they would not welcome him...When the disciples James and John saw this they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to consume them?" Jesus turned and rebuked them, and they journeyed to another village. We've come a long way since then, right? WRONG! The Church really doesn't face new challenges. Instead, she faces old challenges with new faces! We think of our modern society as being so much more tolerant, compassionate, understanding and forgiving than that of the Romans and Pharisees. Well, the Paula Deen incident brings us back to reality, to earth, to the olden days, when people were stoned to death for committing grave sins! Of course, Ms. Deen isn't physically getting stoned to death, like in the olden days. No, we've come a long way since then. We don't guillotine people anymore; we electrocute them! And in keeping with the times, we don't throw stones anymore; we electronically throw them with our anonymous tweets and comments. Yes, we can be very bruising to those we disagree with. And these bruises stick forever! The horrors of the Internet are really the horrors of our very own weaknesses; and more than ever before, more people can become well acquainted with these horrors. Yesterday, I wrote on my twitter: "The dumping of Paula Deen by so many companies highlights the fact that they are as unforgiving as the Pharisees and Scribes of yore. God forbid that any of us show how human we are!" BEWARE OF THY HUMANITY! Now here is a twist for you: The very institution that is often cited for being the most intolerant and unforgiving of all, is the only institution on the face of the earth that is truly the most tolerant and forgiving of all! And that institution is the Roman Catholic Church. Like so many of us, Paula Deen made some serious mistakes in her past. As a result, many institutions, that once promoted her, have cut their ties with her. Did anyone from the Confessional ever tell you to stop coming to Church? No. Just recently she apologized for her mistakes. Guess what? Her apology was not accepted. So not only is our "culture" and "society" hostile and condemning to those who err, but it is also extremely comfortable - confident - in judging someone's apology as insincere. I don't know about you, but I have never questioned in the Confessional someone's apology. Why? Because I'm not qualified to do so. I'm only human! Of course, we have to make judgment calls all the time, but to judge someone's apology? Well, that is truly judging someone the WRONG WAY! Who am I to judge someone's apology? Who am I to be able to enter someone's heart and mind? I am just a "somebody;" or better yet, a "nobody." I love you, but... Lord, I will follow you, but let me say farewell to my family at home. The reason why we have such a hard time forgiving is because we do a very bad job at reflecting - re-living - our past. No regrets, just happiness! Isn't this the latest quirky saying? Ah yes, "no regrets, only happiness!" But remembering the past allows us to respond better to the challenges of the present! To say "no regrets" is to close our life to cross-examination and self-examination. It's a defense mechanism that's based on fear. If we do not occasionally reflect on the past, then we will most likely repeat the errors of the past; we will continue to devour and bite one another (cf. Gal 5:13-18). Then and now. At a certain moment during the Oscar awards ceremony, "Hollywood" paid tribute to the song writer Marvin Hamlisch. Soon after that, Barbara Streisand came out on stage. I couldn't believe it! I can't stand watching her or listening to her. As she began to sing the song "Memories", it was as if I had been transported to another time and another place: my home. I remember playing this song on the piano with all my cousins around me singing along. It was a very welcomed memory, full of youthfulness and funniness. Memories are a gift from God to man. They keep us going. They keep our marriage going. They keep romance in motion. They remind us of what we should remember. They give us a reason to laugh, to cry and to smile. What are you smiling at? Oh, nothing. I find it interesting how certain illnesses do not allow us to remember the "now" in our lives but only the past. I don't know, maybe this means something. Maybe it means that we can live without the now, but we could never live without a past. The Jews were constantly reflecting on their past and learning a great deal from it. Many times, their toughest questions were answered based on past experiences. Our past is a great resource. It is subject to constant re-interpretation. To reflect on the past is not an escape from reality; to live in it is! We have memories. We can relive certain moments, even tough moments, in our lives. The least memories I have of all the years of my life are the years that I worked at Kodak. They are like lost years. I don't even remember the names of the people I worked with. Many times, I find myself going back to my seminary days in order to strengthen my resolve for the day. All of us need to do that, especially for our marriage and for our children. Remember my dear couples when you used to hold your future spouse's hand, even while you were driving, and driving a standard car??? Remember when you always sat next to them at parties and dances? Remember when you used to go on a date? Remember, moms and dads, when your teen was only five years old. Believe me, it's much easier to love your teen when you remember them being five! Our memories can help strengthen our most meaningful relationships!





13ème dimanche du Temps Ordinaire — Année C



Bien aimés frères et sœurs, chers amis,

Après les solennités de la Pentecôte, de la Sainte Trinité, du Saint Sacrement et du Sacré Cœur, nous voilà revenus au TEMPS ORDINAIRE. Aujourd'hui, 13ème Dimanche déjà... Il me plaît de commencer cette méditation par une analogie : Le rétroviseur est un instrument indispensable pour la conduite de tout véhicule. Il nous permet d'anticiper les mouvements de ceux qui nous suivent, de faire les manœuvres nécessaires. Et ce n'est pas pour rien que le code de la route exige depuis plusieurs années que tout véhicule soit équipé d'un rétroviseur intérieur et de deux extérieurs. Belle invention donc que le rétroviseur. Il nous facilite drôlement la vie lorsque nous conduisons. Si cet équipement est plus qu'utile pour tout véhicule, il semble qu'il n'en aille pas de même pour celles et ceux qui veulent inscrire leur vie en Dieu. En effet, d'après les lectures de ce jour, Dieu ne semble pas aimer les gens qui vivent leur vie en regardant en arrière. Il nous attend dans la construction de nos vies, c'est-à-dire le **regard tourné vers l'avenir, vers demain**. Il nous convie à ne pas nous enfermer dans un passé à jamais dépassé. Dans la foi, nous sommes appelés à devenir des visionnaires de la Création. Nous ne sommes pas poussés irrémédiablement par notre passé. Non, nous sommes tirés par notre avenir. La vie s'écrit en avant. C'est là qu'elle se réalise pleinement dans le projet divin. Les différentes images fortes utilisées par le Christ en ce dimanche en disent long : "laisse les morts enterrer leurs morts" ou encore "celui qui met la main à la charre et regarde en arrière n'est pas fait pour le royaume de Dieu". Ces phrases sont dures. Dieu le Fils est venu nous bousculer dans nos certitudes, dans nos paralysies, surtout celles qui affectent les autres et empêchent toute vision d'avenir. Un peu comme si Dieu n'aimait pas les "ont été" ce qui constitue l'apanage de ceux qui ressassent le passé, qui justifient tous leurs actes d'aujourd'hui au nom de l'histoire. Ces gens-là, ces "ont été" conjuguent leur vie au passé composé. Ils se sont enfermés dans une marre de leur histoire alors que le fleuve continue de couler. Ils parsèment leurs phrases de "j'ai été", "nous avons été" et ils pensent que parce qu'ils "ont été", ils ont des droits acquis. Avec les "ont été", aucune remise en question n'est possible puisqu'ils ne font référence qu'à leur passé, aussi glorieux ce dernier ait-il pu être. Dès qu'il peut y avoir une évolution, un regard vers l'avenir les "ont été" s'indignent, crient à l'injustice. Ils ont un grand défaut : ils accusent toujours les autres sans pour autant se rendre compte que leurs propres accusations souvent dénoncent leurs propres conduites. Les "ont été" vivent dans le passé, à ce point aveuglés dans leur présent, qu'ils sont incapables de voir et de comprendre l'avenir. Non pas qu'ils en sont exclus, plutôt ils s'en sont exclus de par leur propre attitude. En effet, les "ont été" sont souvent des entêtés. Et c'est pour toutes ces raisons-là que le Christ nous propose en méditation aujourd'hui des phrases aussi fortes de sens. Voulons-nous être des "ont été" entêtés qui n'acceptent pas de mourir à leurs projets pour en laisser naître d'autres ou désirons-nous écrire nos vies avec l'encre de Dieu c'est-à-dire tourner vers demain ? Le Christ ne nous laisse pas tellement le choix. Par définition, depuis l'instant de notre conception, nous sommes des êtres en devenir, jamais atteints, toujours en évolution. Le jour où nous nous arrêtons nous mourrons. Il est vrai qu'il est parfois plus facile de vivre sa vie au passé composé. C'est rassurant car ayant fait l'expérience, nous connaissons les tenants et aboutissants. Nous n'avons pas peur puisque nous regardons en arrière dans notre histoire. Nous vivons le déjà connu, le déjà vécu. Nous sommes emprisonnés dans notre passé. Or si le Christ, nous dit saint Paul, nous a libérés, c'est pour que nous soyons vraiment libres. En Dieu, nous avons été appelés à la liberté. Une liberté tournée vers l'avenir, par amour, au service les uns des autres. Ne nous enfermons pas dans notre passé mais intégrons-le à nos histoires respectives. Reconnaissions qu'il est dépassé à jamais mais qu'il constitue la richesse de ce que nous sommes devenus. Libérons-nous de tous ces passés composés qui jalonnent nos existences, de tous ces pardons qui n'ont pu être donnés, de toutes ces blessures qui nous ont lézardé. Libérons-nous de tout ce qui nous empêche d'advenir, quittons tous nos masques de "ont été" pour nous tourner à jamais en Dieu vers l'avenir. C'est là que l'Esprit de Dieu nous accompagne. Bon et sanctifiant Dimanche à tous et à chacun.




NOVENA POR EL DÍA DEL PADRE


