

FROM THE PASTOR



Into whatever house you enter, first say, "Peace to this household." If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him."

"Why?" is the most difficult question for a priest to answer upon the death of young child's father. But when I think about it, the "why of anything" is a difficult question to answer, period. We are accustomed to thinking that the question "Why?" is the same as "What causes this to happen?" They are not. "What causes the sky to be blue?" is an easy question to answer. "Why is the sky blue?" is a totally different question. The question can only be answered if we go back to the very beginning.

I mentioned a while back a gentleman that began a conversation with me on a flight. He asked me why I believed in God. I asked him why he didn't. He told me because he believed the Universe began out of an explosion of energy. I told him I believed that it began out of an explosion of love. Why did the Egyptians leave utensils and practical items in a dead man's grave? Was it an expression of a man's journey to the afterlife or was it an expression of care and devotion? Why do we place flowers upon a coffin? Is it to decorate the coffin or is it an expression of love? Why do we give fruits and bake cakes and make soups for a dead man's family? Is it because we need to eat or is it because we love to show our love? The answer is obvious: it is both. All these serve a purpose. It is not one or the other. It is both.

Why do we have to die? We really can't answer this question until we answer the question "Why do we live?" Do we live so that we can die or is it so that we can love and be loved? Was I created from an explosion of cells or from an explosion of love? The answer is simple: It is both. Love given and love returned. Life is an expression of God's love for us. As a worker in the Lord's vineyard, I see things so differently. Every time I meet someone, I see them as a gift from God. A family I meet is a love bouquet from God. A young man and woman, a child, is like a flower that has been hand delivered to me. Why do we have to die? Is it out of necessity or is it out of love? The answer is both. "Jesus said, 'Father, I thank you for hearing me. I know that you always hear me; but because of the crowd here I have said this, that they may believe that you sent me.' Then he cried out in a loud voice, 'Lazarus, come out!'" (John 11:38-44). Why did Christ have to die? Was it out of necessity or was it out of love? The answer is both. The Lord had to die to ransom us from our sins. He also died to show us His unconditional love for us.

If we could only see this in every one we meet! How differently we would live. How beautifully we would live. How lovingly we would live. Peace would reign in every single household! This is the reason why the disciples entered a village, stayed in someone's home and preached the Good News. Did they do this because they were told to? Yes. Did they do this because they wanted to? Yes. Did they do this because they loved to? Yes. They knew what they were sent to do: To love and be loved. This is the reason for the Universe. This is the reason for life on earth. This is the reason for my life and death. This is the reason for everlasting life! So, do we kiss someone because we want to taste them? Maybe. But if we begin to kiss someone because we love them (and not because we wish to betray them!), then we will start living a more profound and deeper existence, and we shall receive a just payment!

To love and be loved. This is the why we are who we are and why we do what we do. We learned it from Him who loved us first. When we start doing what we were meant to do, we will answer all life's difficult questions.



Mot de notre Aumônier

Bien aimés frères et sœurs, chers amis,

Aujourd'hui, nous commençons une nouvelle année pastorale. La célébration de notre eucharistie intègre donc à la fin les bilans du CPA et du CFA et la présentation de tous les groupes, mouvements et associations de l'ACAF. L'évangile de ce 14ème dimanche nous remet devant notre tâche essentielle : notre mission. En effet, si, comme Marc et Matthieu, Luc a raconté l'envoi des 12 apôtres, il a ajouté en outre l'envoi des 72 disciples (72, c'est le nombre biblique des nations – Cf Gn 10). Donc cela signifie que la mission doit être l'œuvre de tous les disciples, tous les chrétiens et qu'elle doit être universelle, toucher tous les peuples. Mais le point de départ est et reste LA PRIERE. « Jésus leur dit en effet : " La moisson est abondante mais les ouvriers sont peu nombreux !!! Priez donc le maître de la moisson d'envoyer des ouvriers à sa moisson". Avant de s'élaner à toutes jambes dans le terrain de l'apostolat, le disciple doit d'abord plier les genoux, prier, ouvrir les yeux sur l'immensité de la tâche à remplir...et s'effrayer de la disproportion des effectifs. Si peu de chrétiens s'engagent, si peu comprennent l'obligation de leur baptême ! Pourtant c'est l'heure de moissonner ! Beaucoup de gens sont mûrs, prêts à entrer dans le Royaume...si on leur en parle, si on les

appelle ! Mais Dieu seul a l'initiative de l'envoi. Le salut du monde est une œuvre divine ; chaque fois que des hommes ont cru comment, par eux seuls, sauver l'humanité, on est allé à la catastrophe. Donc il faut se jeter dans la PRIERE : c'est elle qui nous convaincra de notre petitesse, nous remplira le cœur de compassion, nous fera partager l'angoisse devant tant de vies perdues, tant de gâchis. Saint Dominique pleurait des nuits entières devant le tabernacle sur tant d'hommes qui se perdaient faute d'Évangile ! La prière nous persuadera que nous ne sommes que des envoyés. Mais est-il plus haute gloire que d'être "un envoyé de Dieu" ?...

« Je vous envoie comme des agneaux au milieu des loups. » dit le Maître. Jésus se comprend comme celui qui peut immédiatement transmettre l'ordre de Dieu, "maître de la moisson". Il ne nous envoie pas comme des dirigeants, des maîtres, des savants mais comme des êtres fragiles, vulnérables, exposés aux attaques. Vous expérimenterez l'opposition, l'hostilité, la haine. Même vos proches seront irrités, exaspérés. Des loups, des hommes voraces, cherchant à accumuler sans frein, à jouir sans mesure, feront tout pour vous détruire. Surtout ne les imitez pas, ne soyez jamais une Église puissante, ne recourez pas à la force, n'ayez d'autre armure que la foi. "C'est quand je suis faible que je suis fort...La puissance de Dieu se déploie dans la faiblesse" (Saint Paul). Et pour cela, « n'emportez ni argent, ni sac, ni sandales et ne vous attardez pas en salutations sur la route ». Ne pas s'encombrer, ne pas se surcharger de provisions, au contraire se dépouiller, adopter une vie frugale. Comment convertir les idolâtres de la société de consommation s'ils remarquent (comme hélas, trop souvent !) que les chrétiens sont autant préoccupés qu'eux du "tout confort" ? Seule une Église pauvre peut remplir sa mission. Et ça urge ! Pas de temps à perdre, pas de papotages, de discussions oiseuses : des gens meurent parce que personne ne leur a proposé le salut ! Depuis le Christ, le monde est aux "URGENCES". Toute perte de temps a des résultats mortels : des vies sont en danger, des jeunes sont près du suicide ou de la drogue, des dirigeants cupides vont traiter le personnel comme des kleenex, des gouvernements vont préparer une nouvelle guerre, des sectes rôdent...Comment rester oisifs ?...

« Dans toute ville où vous entrerez et où vous serez accueillis, mangez ce qu'on vous offrira. Là guérissez les malades et dites aux habitants : " Le Règne de Dieu est tout proche de vous" ». La mission chrétienne n'est pas fuite dans la solitude, fondation d'un monde parallèle : elle s'enfonce au cœur des cités, elle rejoint les hommes au sein de leurs demeures. Que fait un missionnaire ? Deux choses : 1) GUERIR LES MALADES. Car le message évangélique n'est pas piété évanescence, envol dans les belles idées théologiques : il concerne l'homme entier, corps et âme. Dans son histoire, l'Église, dans le même élan d'amour, a toujours bâti églises et dispensaires, chapelles et hôpitaux. 2) PRECHER L'EVANGILE. Car la mission n'est pas amélioration humaine des conditions de vie, progrès de la science et de la médecine. Trop de chrétiens se calfeutrent dans une Église désincarnée, trop d'autres la réduisent à une œuvre sociale. L'Église n'est ni une entreprise du salut des âmes par des rites, des cantiques et de la piété - ni une organisation humanitaire et philanthropique. Il faut DIRE le message, car l'homme, seul, ne peut le découvrir. Il faut que certains - pour l'expérimenter eux-mêmes dans leur vie - partagent la découverte qu'ils ont faite : Dieu s'approche, Dieu bienveillant, miséricordieux, doux et humble de cœur, vient en Jésus et ses disciples, il pénètre dans nos maisons. La solitude, la famine, le racisme, la haine ne sont pas des fatalités et on ne peut se limiter à rêver au bonheur dans l'au-delà. C'est ICI et MAINTENANT qu'un nouveau type d'existence est possible, créé par Dieu. La Bonne Nouvelle retentit : quittons nos idoles et nos fantasmes béats et laissons Dieu régner. Bon début d'année pastorale à chacun et sanctifiant dimanche à tous !



3 de julio de 2022

14º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Primera Lectura: Isaías 66:10-14
Segunda Lectura: Gálatas 6:14-18
Evangelio: Lucas 10:1-12, 17-20

“Jesús no quiere obrar solo, vino a traer al mundo el amor de Dios y quiere difundirlo con el estilo de la comunión, con el estilo de la fraternidad. Por ello forma una comunidad de discípulos, que es una comunidad misionera. Inmediatamente los entrena para la misión, para ir. La finalidad es anunciar el Reino de Dios, ¡y esto es urgente! También hoy es urgente” (Papa Francisco). Que importante noticia anuncia Jesús en su tiempo y hoy. Compartir la Buena Nueva a pesar de los tiempos que estamos viviendo. Llevar la alegría a la familia y amigos cercanos de que Jesús está entre nosotros. Y nos envía a la misión como nos lo indica el Papa Francisco.

Ir en misión no es cosa de una sola persona, es cuestión de dos en dos. “Después de esto, el Señor eligió a otros setenta y dos discípulos y los envió de dos en dos, delante de él, a todas las ciudades y lugares a donde debía ir él” (Lucas 120,1-2). 




