

FROM THE PASTOR



Jesus entered a village where a woman whose name was Martha welcomed him. She had a sister named Mary who sat beside the Lord at his feet listening to him speak. Martha, burdened with much serving, came to him, and said, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving?" I know I am a Martha and I know a lot of people who are like Martha! We want to do it all and then we complain that we don't get any help. We don't like to delegate things around the house or at work because we don't want to look weak; we also don't want it done poorly! But then, like always, we get overwhelmed, lash out and fall apart.

When we read this Gospel passage we wish we could be in the Lord's presence, like Martha and Mary. We wish we could have this direct line of communication, like Martha and Mary. I am here to say that this can happen today! We can do exactly the same thing that Martha did: she dropped what she was doing and approached the Lord. This feeling of being overwhelmed (or out of control) is a defense mechanism – an internal alarm - that goes off as a physical and spiritual reminder that it is time to approach the Lord.

But guess what? This is not our problem! Most of us do this pretty well. When we lash out or feel left out; when we lose our sense of direction or purpose in life most of us go straight to the Lord. We know what to do... We will earnestly begin to pray! We will begin a new cycle of daily rosaries and adoration, weekday Masses, and frequent confessions, etc. But then, little by little, as soon as we are feeling well again, we will fall back to our old way of doing things; neglecting the very tools that helped us on our journey back to normalcy.

What the Lord tells us today, as he did yesterday and the day before, is that Mary has chosen the better part. And the better part is to go full throttle after you have prayed! First pray and then work. First know why you are doing what you are doing. First know who you are before you go and try to invent yourself! First seek and then you shall find. First knock and then the door shall be opened. First ask and then you shall receive. Otherwise, we will find what we least wanted; we will open the door we never ever wanted to enter; and we will receive what we never asked for! Blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it!

Yes, blessed are they who are confident in God! Blessed are they who know they are not God! The only superheroes, superstars, supermen and women are those who are meek and humble of heart. We have a tendency, a very natural tendency, to take credit for what we don't deserve. We take credit for our Universe, our planet, our life, our work and our decisions. We think we know it all and we know nothing when it comes to life. We are still trying to figure out how to raise children for God sakes!

Let us ask the Lord to remove this ailment from our lives. Let us ask the Lord to take a moment out of our busy schedule to sit, kneel and prostrate ourselves before the Lord who is King of the Universe, King of the World and King of my life!

The Lord is good to those who hope in him, to those who are searching for his love. (Lam 3:25)





Mot de notre Aumônier

Bien aimés frères et sœurs, chers amis,

En ce 16ème Dimanche du Temps Ordinaire, nous voilà aux prises avec un déconcertant Jésus : il venait de nous exhorter Dimanche dernier à être de bon Samaritains, à nous dévouer sans compter au service de tout blessé rencontré sur notre chemin et voilà qu'aujourd'hui il calme les ardeurs de l'hôtesse qui s'empressait de bien le recevoir avec ses apôtres.

L'histoire de Marthe et Marie est bien connue et on a fait de ces deux femmes les modèles de deux vocations : la vie active et la vie contemplative. L'apostolat et la prière. Le dévouement bruyant et l'oraison silencieuse. Et on a donné le primat à cette dernière. Est-ce cela que le texte veut dire ? Cette scène ne fonde donc pas deux genres de vie religieuse, comme s'il fallait opposer activité et prière. Les deux sont nécessaires et s'entrecroisent. Marthe, bien intentionnée, en faisait trop : son empressement n'était-il pas entaché du désir de se montrer la meilleure, la plus douée ? « Je vais vous montrer de quoi je suis capable ». Aujourd'hui n'y a-t-il pas une surenchère de bouffe ? La télévision n'en finit pas de parler de cuisine. L'embonpoint des uns nargue la famine des autres. Retour à la simplicité svp ! Quant à Marie, elle aurait sans doute dû donner un coup de main mais elle avait pressenti qu'avant de nourrir Jésus, il fallait au préalable et avant tout s'alimenter à sa Parole. L'écoute, après avoir été le premier principe de la foi dans l'Ancienne Alliance où la prière oblige à dire deux fois par jour : « Ecoute, Israël... », est tout autant, sinon davantage, l'appel n° 1 de l'Evangile. La première scène de Jésus sortant de l'enfance est celle de son recouvrement : ses parents, éperdus, le retrouvent « dans le temple, assis au milieu des maîtres, à les écouter et les interroger ». (2, 46) Et lorsque les nouveaux baptisés affluèrent dans la première Eglise de Jérusalem, les Apôtres, submergés de travail, décidèrent de nommer des diacres pour veiller au service des tables et à la juste répartition de nourriture pour les pauvres ;

Quant à nous, dit Pierre avec les apôtres, nous continuerons à assurer la prière et le service de la Parole » (Ac 6, 4). Annoncer la Parole libératrice reste toujours prioritaire pour tout chrétien. Aujourd'hui nous dirons notre reconnaissance à toutes les mamans, les maîtresses de maison, le personnel des restaurants qui se donnent tant de peine pour préparer, chaque jour, les repas pour les convives (qui ne les en remercient pas assez). Respectons Marthe. Sainte Thérèse d'Avila disait à ses carmélites tentées d'aller somnoler devant le S. Sacrement : « Dieu est dans nos casseroles, mes sœurs !! » Nous réfléchissons à l'urgence de constituer de petits groupes où les chrétiens s'invitent les uns chez les autres non pour des rivalités gastronomiques mais pour partager, dans la frugalité, « la nourriture de l'Evangile. C'est en recevant par elle lumière et force qu'ils pourront s'employer à la réforme de l'Eglise. Nous nous déciderons à nous asseoir, à réduire le temps et la fatigue des soucis superflus pour nous consacrer à « l'unique nécessaire » : « dévorer l'Evangile. Chers amis, pourquoi ne dirions-nous pas avec le petit Samuel : Parle, Seigneur, ton serviteur écoute » et avec Marie de Nazareth : Je suis la servante du Seigneur : qu'il m'arrive selon sa Parole.

Je vous souhaite une sanctifiante journée dominicale aussi bien dans l'activisme que dans la contemplation. Dieu vous bénisse !


16º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Primera Lectura: Génesis 18:1-10
Segunda Lectura: Colosenses 1: 24-28
Evangelio: Lucas 10:38-42

Nos pasamos nuestra vida, desde que tenemos uso de razón hasta el final de los días, tratando de elegir lo mejor, ser lo mejor, vestir y comer lo mejor. Grandes pensadores, filósofos y consejeros, por mencionar algunos, escriben libros, dan conferencias con la misma meta y siempre con el mismo objetivo: “Que sepamos elegir en la vida lo mejor”. El domingo pasado escuchábamos como el buen samaritano y el posadero hicieron lo mejor para el pobre hombre que fue asaltado en el camino. Hoy, la Liturgia nos presenta otra escena en el Evangelio de Lucas: ¿Cómo saber elegir lo mejor?

Jesús, nos narra el Evangelio... entró a un pueblo donde vivían Marta y María, quienes lo recibieron en su casa. Ambas mujeres, me imagino, conocían a Jesús. Este es un punto interesante, ya que Martha eligió la parte del trabajo, sin fijarse en la importancia del invitado. Iba y venía atendiendo los quehaceres, sin prestar la mayor atención. Hasta que de repente, notó que su hermana estaba muy sin prisa, sentada a los pies de Jesús, escuchándolo. Es por esta razón que Martha se atreve a reclamar a Jesús: “Señor, ¿no te importa que mi hermana me haya dejado sola para atender? Dile que me ayude. Pero el Señor respondió: Marta, Marta, tú andas preocupada y te pierdes en mil cosas: una sola es necesaria. María ha elegido la mejor parte, que no le será quitada” (Lucas 10,40-42). Nadie nos separará del amor de Cristo, y ese amor nos hará perfectos, dice San Pablo. ©LPi

MISA Y UNCIÓN PARA ENFERMOS

Se les invita a la Misa mensual y la unción de Enfermos en español el 29 de julio a las 7:00 p.m.

En el sacramento de la Unción de los enfermos de la Iglesia, mediante el ministerio del sacerdote, es Jesús quien toca al enfermo para curarlo de sus pecados, y a veces incluso de la enfermedad física. Sus curaciones eran signos de la llegada del Reino de Dios. El mensaje central de sus curaciones nos dice de su plan de conquistar el pecado y la muerte con su muerte y resurrección.

El ritual de la Unción nos dice que no tenemos que esperar a que una persona esté a las puertas de la muerte para recibir el sacramento. Un juicio cuidadoso sobre la seriedad de la naturaleza de la enfermedad es suficiente.

Cuando se administra el sacramento de la Unción de los enfermos, el efecto que se espera es que, si Dios quiere, la persona sane físicamente de su enfermedad. Pero incluso si no hay sanación física, el principal efecto del sacramento es la curación espiritual mediante la cual el enfermo recibe el don del Espíritu Santo y la valentía para afrontar las dificultades que acompañan una grave enfermedad o la fragilidad de la vejez.

En el caso de enfermos por COVID, por favor llame a la oficina para información sobre como administrarse este sacramento en estas circunstancias; ya que por seguridad no pueden asistir a esta Misa de Sanación.
