

ANNOUNCEMENT FROM CARDINAL DINARDO

Dear St. John Fisher Parishioners,

Cardinal Daniel DiNardo has issued a decree removing the general dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day Mass Obligation effective Sunday, January 2nd, 2022, the solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord.

Cardinal DiNardo is asking the Catholic faithful of our Archdiocese to resume regular Sunday Mass attendance. Still, please note that the normal dispensations (those who find it impossible to attend Mass due to illness, advanced age, caring for a sick person, or being at elevated risk of contracting COVID-19) are still in place. Those who cannot attend Mass for one of those reasons are encouraged to watch a live-streamed Mass and meditate upon the Scriptures at home. For the time being, the suspension of receiving the Precious Blood from a common chalice remains in effect.

We are excited to celebrate our upcoming Christmas liturgies with you and welcome everyone back to the parish in the New Year. Together let us continue to open our hearts and minds and glorify the Lord in 2022!

El cardenal Daniel DiNardo ha emitido un decreto que elimina la dispensa general de la obligación de la misa dominical y del día santo a partir del domingo 2 de enero de 2022, solemnidad de la Epifanía del Señor.

El cardenal DiNardo está pidiendo a los fieles católicos de nuestra Arquidiócesis que reanuden la asistencia regular a la misa dominical. Aún así, tenga en cuenta que las dispensaciones normales (aquellos a quienes les resulta imposible asistir a misa debido a una enfermedad, edad avanzada, cuidado de una persona enferma o que tienen un riesgo elevado de contraer COVID-19) todavía están vigentes. A los que no puedan asistir por una de esas razones se les anima a ver una Misa en vivo y meditar sobre las Escrituras en casa. Por el momento, se mantiene vigente la suspensión de recibir la Preciosa Sangre de un cáliz común.

Estamos emocionados de celebrar nuestras próximas liturgias navideñas con ustedes y les damos la bienvenida a todos a la parroquia en el Año Nuevo. ¡Juntos continuemos abriendo corazones y mentes y glorifiquemos al Señor en 2022!


