FROM THE DESK OF FR. CHAD

Dear Friends,

As I talked about at Mass this past weekend, we are continuing with our “temporary” Mass schedule for the time being. When we began the “temporary” schedule last year, we didn’t expect “temporary” to last this long—but, there are signs that we are getting closer to once again establishing a permanent schedule.



As of now, the temporary schedule is able to accommodate all those who are coming to Mass in person on a weekend. If more people continue to attend in person and that exceeds our capacity, then we will look at the possibility of adding an additional Mass. Also, things “normalizing” in society will be an indication that it is time to discern a permanent schedule. My hope is that we will begin this discernment sometime this summer. There are many factors that will go into determining the permanent schedule, such as: parishioner input, number of Masses needed to accommodate the number of people attending, our faith formation schedule and the availability of priests to help (such as a weekend assistant).

Thank you for your patience and understanding throughout this temporary schedule. I know that it has required many of you to adjust your personal schedule. I am grateful for your flexibility, and look forward to working together to establish a permanent schedule soon.


STEWARDSHIP MESSAGE




