Catholic Relief Services is well-respected and trusted in the international community and that means they are asked to do a wide variety of good things in our world. Here is just one example:

Until March of this year, if Nuer villagers from Panyok in South Sudan's Uror county wanted to travel to the nearest town, Pajut, they had to walk for hours on a narrow footpath through the bush, which left them vulnerable to bandits. Now, through a European Union-funded cash-for-work initiative, they have joined together with nearby Dinka communities to build a 10-mile road connecting Panyok to Pajut. The Panyok-Pajut road is part of the Building a Culture of Social Cohesion and Peace project funded by the European Union and implemented by Catholic Relief Services. For

Dear Friends,

Two of our parish staff members recently announced that they've made the decision to depart from their positions at Mary, Queen of Peace: Julianna Castro (Pastoral Assistant for Liturgy) and Marissa Schulz (Pastoral Assistant for Faith Formation & Catechesis).



Julianna has served on the parish staff for over three years. We're grateful for how well organized and beautifully celebrated liturgies have been during her time here, and how she helped us adapt to safety protocols during the pandemic. Her responsibilities in liturgy will be covered by other current staff members, primarily by Zoltan Abraham and Karen Hauser. We will also be inviting parishioners who serve in liturgical ministries to assume more leadership of some of these roles. Her last day on the parish staff will be July 6th.

Marissa has served on the parish staff for almost two years (in addition to a previous time that she served on the parish staff). We're grateful for how she was able to quickly step in and effectively lead ministries, including adapting to the limitations from the pandemic. First, for over a year as the interim Youth Minister for Middle and High School (before the arrival of our current Youth Minister, Nathan Scott). Then, since January, focusing on ministries to children and families, including the completion of preparing our children for First Communion. Her most recent responsibilities will be covered by our upcoming new hire for Children and Family Faith Formation. We will also be inviting parishioners to help serve in these ministries. Her last day on the parish staff will be June 30th.

Please join me in thanking Julianna and Marissa for their service to Mary, Queen of Peace! Also, please join me in praying for them, as they continue to discern how God is calling them to love and serve. Furthermore, please join me in thanking and praying for all the parish staff who do such a great job of adjusting to these changes, taking on new roles, and serving the parish so well!

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

Catholic Fiction Book Club:
Exploring the Catholic Imagination
by Zoltan Abraham

Once a month, the MQP Catholic Fiction Book Club discusses one new book. We focus on Catholic authors, or other writers whose interest is Catholic culture or themes. We have learned about English Catholicism from Evelyn Waugh, through his hauntingly beautifully narrated novel *Brideshead Revisited*. We have explored Medieval Norway through the eyes of Kristin Lavransdatter, the titular heroine of a trilogy written by Norwegian writer Sigrid Undset. We experienced the ups and downs of the roaring 20s through the puzzling actions of Mr. Blue, a dedicated Catholic character created by Myles Connolly. We have shared in the joys and sorrows, dreams and failures, of Catholic pioneers, as depicted by the works of Willa Cather. We entered into the enchanting land of Narnia of C.S. Lewis through the famed magic wardrobe alongside the Pevensie children and have spent the last few months exploring that world.

Future discussions will take us to Middle-earth, as we read *The Hobbit* and *The Lord of the Rings*, to the Catholic South through the lens of Flannery O'Connor, and to different parts of the globe as we immerse ourselves in the musings of Graham Greene. And the list goes on!

Our group reads one novel per month, which is a very manageable pace. Currently, we meet on the first Tuesday of the month, but please contact Zoltan Abraham (adulsted@mqp.org) for specific meeting information, just in case that changes. Our book for July is *The Magician's Nephew* by C.S. Lewis, which details the creation of the world of Narnia. Join us as our adventure continues!


