

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. John Paul II | Feast Day October 22

St. John Paul II was born Karol Wojtyla in the small Polish town of Wadowice. During World War II, when the Nazis invaded Poland, Karol secretly studied for the priesthood in an underground seminary. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1946, appointed Archbishop of Krakow in 1964, and three years later he was made a cardinal. In 1978, he was elected the 264th pope, where he took the name John Paul II.

St. John Paul II made evangelization a key part of his papacy and made pastoral visits to all parts of the world. In 1981, he was shot twice in an assassination attempt. Following Jesus' example of compassion, he later met with his would-be assassin in his prison cell, where he forgave him for what he had done.

St. John Paul II was well-known to be an active sportsman throughout his life, hiking and skiing well into his 60s. In 1992, his health began to decline, and it was later discovered that he suffered from Parkinson's disease, a degenerative disorder of the central nervous system.

Near the end of his papacy, it became difficult for him to speak, and his poor health and physical suffering made public appearances difficult. Still, he continued his pastoral work. He died April 2, 2005, and he was declared blessed on May 1, 2011. He became a saint on April 27, 2014.

Our Parish Is Celebrating a Spiritual Adoption

"My Heart Started Beating Today!"

At fertilization, a new human life begins, complete with his or her own unique set of DNA, which is present from the first day of life.

The new little person's sex is also determined from the beginning. During the baby's first amazing month of life, the baby grows to 10,000 times the size at conception. By the third week, the baby's heart begins to beat.

Your Baby's Development - Month One

Your spiritually adopted baby has been quite active over the past month. Your baby has developed the foundations of its brain, spinal cord, and nervous system by the 20th day. The heart began to beat on the 21st day and is pumping blood through its own circulatory system. The blood type can be different from its mother's.



Your baby is most vulnerable during the next month of being aborted. Pray that the Lord of Life might move the heart of the baby's mother to give him or her the most precious gift of all - the gift of life.

The Spiritual Adoption Program

The Knights of Columbus and the Respect Life Committee encourage all parishioners to participate in our Spiritual Adoption Program by making a daily commitment to pray for the health and protection of the pre-born and their parents. Every prayer will be heard and God will bless you abundantly in this ministry of the Gospel of Life.

You may know this child as a member of your own family or you may spiritually adopt a child that you may never know in this life. You may even give a name to this spiritually adopted child. **Watch your adopted baby grow and develop every month as posters on the Kiosk change.**

During your earthly life, this spiritually adopted child will be known only to God but in the world to come it is hoped that you will meet the child whose life was spared by your prayers and spend eternal happiness with them.


