

Merry Christmas! And Happy New Year!

We continue our celebration of the Christmas Season this weekend with the Epiphany of the Lord: "the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Savior of the world" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, para. 528). The word *epiphany* is from the Greek, meaning "to reveal."



On the Epiphany, we are reminded of the Wise Men from the East (the Magi) came to visit the Baby Jesus, and He was thus revealed to the nations. One of the traditions associated with the three Magi is to bless our homes for the New Year. This weekend, we will, once again, bless our home here at church. I encourage you to take home with you a small bag of supplies (including chalk and incense) to bless your own home. 


