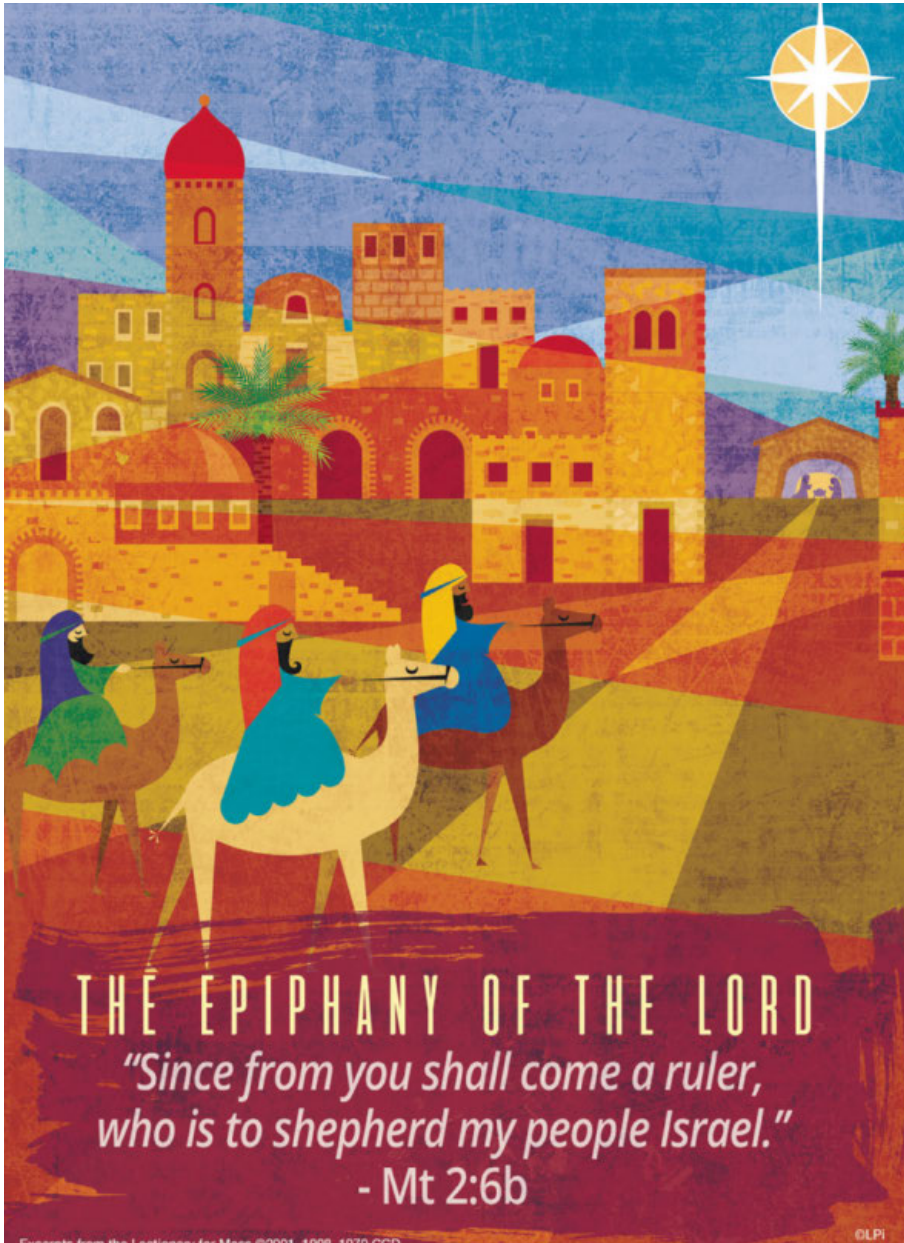

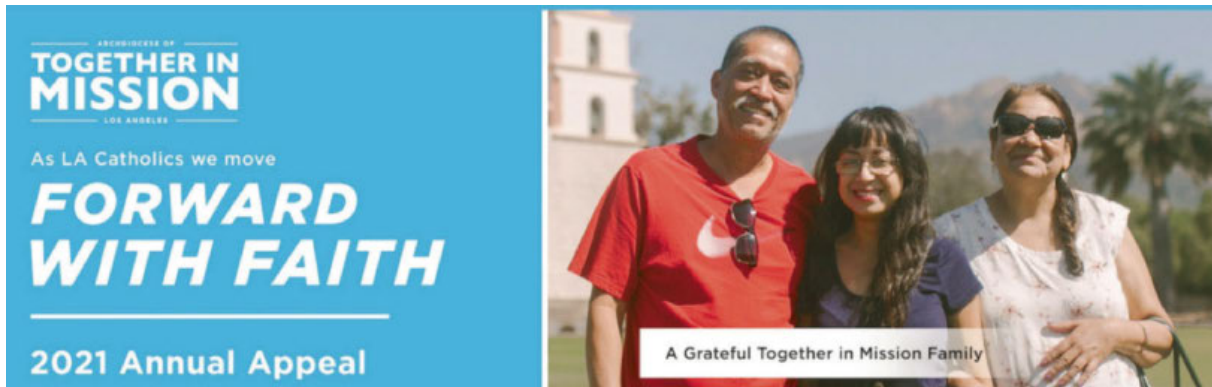

#### Online safety review for the new year
