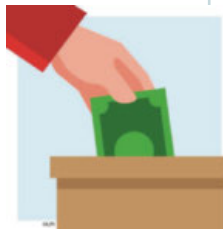

Sixth Sunday of EASTER (Year B)

“Remain in My Love and Bear Fruit”

Today, the Lord Jesus continues to develop **last Sunday’s idea of union with him as a condition to bear fruits of holiness** in our lives. He does so **by emphasizing that keeping his “Love Commandment”** is the practical way to show the reality of our union with him and to bear fruit.

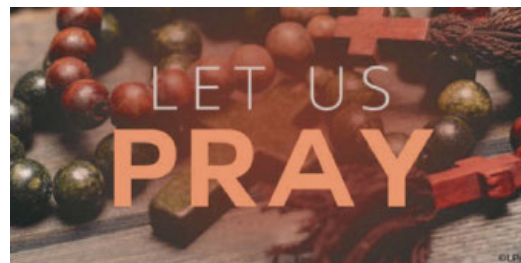

The month of May is dedicated to honoring Mary, Mother of God. This May, join Catholic parishes across the U.S. to drill and repair 109 hand pump wells in Zambia and Malawi in sub-Saharan Africa — blessing mothers, daughters and their families with safe, clean water.

When Happy Mhango's husband died unexpectedly in 2020, it felt like the world was collapsing around her. Suddenly, she had to find a way to provide for her four children. At the same time, she was suffering from terrible neck and shoulder pain caused by carrying heavy buckets of water from a distant river.

In these troubled times, Happy turned to Christ and his Church. Immediately, she found comfort and aid through her local Catholic community — neighbors who were poor themselves but willing to give what little they had to a family in greater need. Slowly, she began to smile again. Happy received her First Communion in 2021, and in October 2022 her faith was confirmed when her diocese built a village well just minutes from her home.

"My pain has disappeared!" Happy beamed. "Please give to help our friends who do not have water. The joy in our community is great, and we want others to experience the same joy."

As a parish family, we can extend similar blessings to families in Africa who thirst for a clean, safe drink — and the soul-transforming gift of Christ's living water.

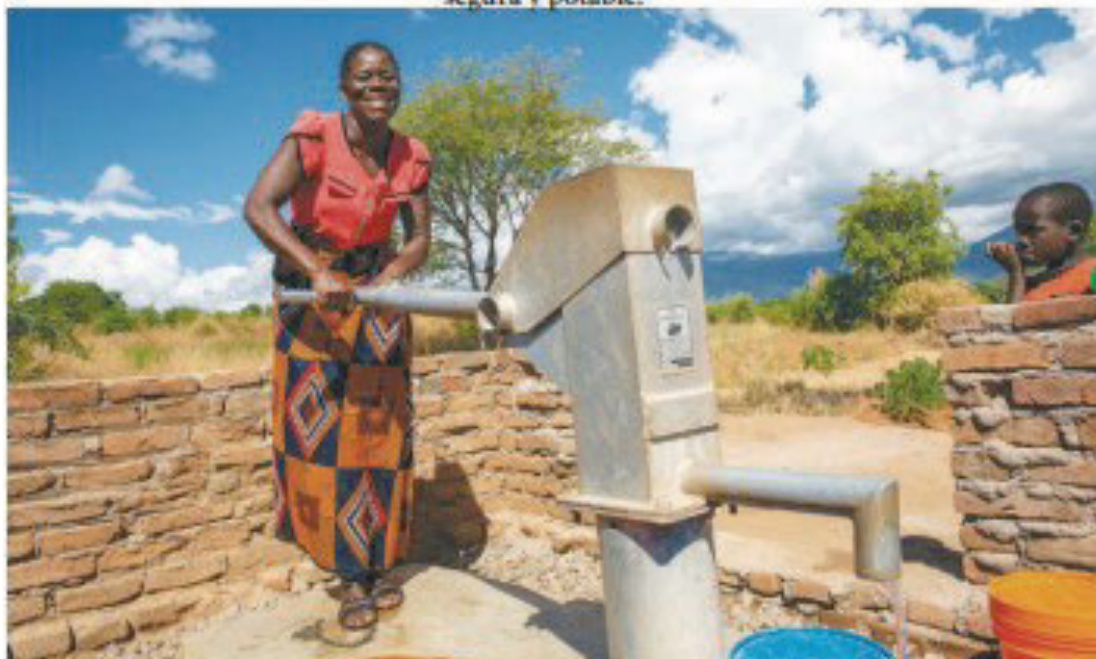

Cuando el esposo de Happy Mhango falleció de manera inesperada en 2020, parecía que el mundo se derrumbaba a su alrededor. De repente, Happy tenía que encontrar la manera de sacar adelante a sus cuatro hijos. A la vez, ella padecía de un dolor terrible en el cuello y en el hombro provocado por cargar baldes pesados con agua desde un río distante.

En estos tiempos tan difíciles, Happy acudió a Cristo y a su Iglesia. De inmediato, encontró consuelo y ayuda a través de su comunidad católica local; vecinos que aun siendo pobres estaban dispuestos a donar lo poco que tenían a una familia con mayor necesidad. Gradualmente, ella empezó a sonreír de nuevo. Happy recibió su primera comunión en 2021, y en octubre de 2022 se confirmó su fe cuando su diócesis construyó un pozo comunitario a tan solo un par de minutos de su casa.

“¡Mi dolor desapareció!” dijo sonriendo Happy. “Por favor, done para ayudar a nuestros amigos que no disponen de agua. La alegría en nuestra comunidad es enorme, y queremos que otros experimenten la misma alegría.”

Como familia parroquial, podemos extender bendiciones similares a las familias en África que tienen ansias de una bebida limpia y segura, y el regalo del agua viva de Cristo que transforma almas.

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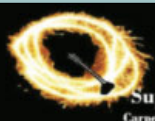
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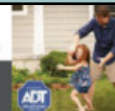
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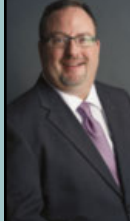
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
