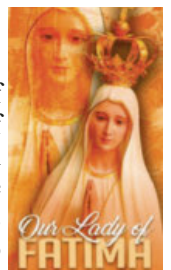


## Did you Know? Bullying and disabilities

A child with a disability, such as hearing loss, language impairment, learning disabilities, or physical disabilities, is often at increased risk for bullying. Children who struggle to understand social cues or control impulsive physical behaviors are also at increased risk, as bullies may see this behavior as aggressive, prompting an aggressive response. Children with learning disabilities are also sometimes easy targets for theft and vandalism. In schools, teachers and volunteers should be aware of these extra risks and watch for red flags. 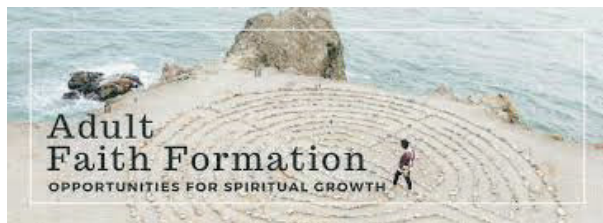

## Stewardship Reflection

*"This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." - John 15:12-13*

Do you love Jesus? Do you consider Him your friend? Jesus says that if we love Him we would be willing to offer whatever we have to Him, not because we want praise and glory, but simply because we love Him. Does your giving seem mechanical out of obligation or do you share freely out of love? parish and other Church needs? If not, it's not too late to start!

## Reflections - John 15:9-17



In today's gospel, Jesus affirms what he has elsewhere revealed as the greatest commandment: love. God has loved his Son so he can love us, and we are likewise called to love because we are loved. We are so loved

that Jesus gave his life for us. We are so loved that Jesus relinquishes his role as master that leaves us as slaves. He yet again tips the power scales that the secular world so treasures. We are rather his friends, elevated to a sharing in his life and his relationship with God the Father. Jesus shares everything he has with us; his love, his healing, his life are all now ours.

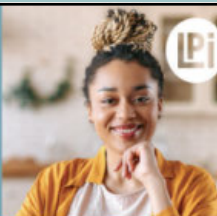
