## Saint of the Week

Saint Germaine was born in Pibrac, France in 1579 to poor parents. Her story is a heart wrenching one. She was born with a deformed right arm and hand, and her mother died when she was an infant. Her father remarried, but her stepmother brutally abused and neglected her.

As a child Germaine suffered from scrofula, a disfiguring form of tuberculosis which causes swelling and lesions on the side of the neck. Already sick, abused, and starving, she was forced to sleep in barn with sheep she tended. Despite everything, Germaine lived each day tending her flock with joy and in prayer. Mary and Jesus became her friends. She shared what little she had and taught the children of the village about God's love. A rosary made of string knots was her constant companion. She attended Mass every day, leaving her sheep in care of guardian angels. Her flock was never attacked by wolves and never wandered. Some claimed to see the waters of the flooded river part so she could get to Mass. She is often portrayed with an apron full of flowers because one winter day her stepmother accused her of stealing bread from the house and hiding it her apron. But when she was seized and forced to open the apron an abundance of spring flowers tumbled forth. It was this incident that compelled the villagers and even her parents to recognize her holiness. Germaine died at 22, her poor body was found by her father, in the barn where she slept. She was buried in the village church. More than forty years later, her body was accidentally exhumed and found to be incorrupt. She was canonized by Pope Pius IX in 1867 and inscribed into the canon of virgins.

# RENOVATION UPDATES

What has already happened?

- The small organ at the front of the Church has been removed to create space for a statue of the Blessed Disciple. The organ has been safely stored as we await a buyer to give it a new home.
- A small construction trailer has been placed by the port cochere. This will serve as the office and headquarters for our contractor and foreman during the renovation process. A small construction dumpster delivery is pending.

What's happening next?

- Temporary walls will soon be built at the front of the Church to contain the demolition and construction of the new niches for the Blessed Mother and Beloved Disciple statues. This will require a temporary change to the flow of the Communion Procession at Mass.
- The large organ in the back of the Church will be covered to protect it during the demolition process. We will use only the piano for a few weeks during the demolition.

# FOOD FOR THE POOR

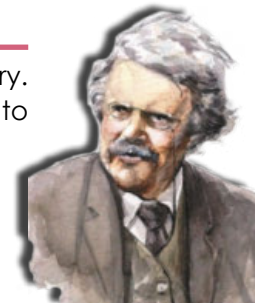

### Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Thank you for supporting the fellowship and service opportunities of the Women's Club, as well as the social needs of the parish. The Women's Club encourages all women of the parish to participate in service to the St. Cecilia Community. The **areas of service** are as follows:

The **Altar Guilds** are a 12 month ministry to help with light house cleaning in the Sanctuary and Chapel. Each volunteer and her Guild partner work 1 to 2 hours, **once or twice** during the year. Keeping God's house clean usually takes place on Fridays.

The **Good Neighbor Committee** is a 12 month ministry for planning and hosting funeral receptions. Volunteers can provide food and/or help with set-up, serving or clean-up afterward. Consider becoming a one-month chair.

The **Hospitality Committee** provides for light refreshments at Club general membership meetings. They also provide table décor and direct the set up and clean-up for Club's special lunches. No washing dishes on this Committee!

The **Program Committee** works as an advisory committee to the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President – Programs to bring entertaining and unusual programs and events for our membership meetings.

The **Social Committee** has a two-fold focus. It helps organize and carry out special parish receptions such as for recognizing departing or retiring parish staff. The committee staffs the Club's Oktoberfest booth, proceeds of which go directly into the Oktoberfest coffers to reduce parish debt.

The **Communications Committee's** telephone tree and e-blast are the lifelines used to contact members about our events and with special announcements. Telephone callers contact those who do not have/use email.

The **Ways and Means Committee** is responsible for all fund-raising for the Club's discretionary use. The proceeds fund our scholarship for St. Cecilia School and other parish gifts. A raffle is held during the May off-site luncheon. May raffle proceeds go directly to Angela House.

\*An **Associate membership** is available for members who are unable to actively participate in Club functions. (Bylaws, Article III)

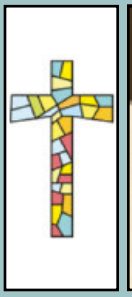
