Saint of the Week

Saint Oliver Plunkett was the last Roman Catholic Martyr to die in England. He was canonized in 1975, the first new Irish saint in almost 700 years.

Oliver was born in Loughcrew, Oldcastle, County Meath in November 1625, the son of the Baron of Loughcrew. As a young man, he wanted to become a priest, but it was illegal to travel to the continent to enter seminary. Even so, he undertook the dangerous journey with four other young men and a Papal Envoy. They were pursued by English privateers, storms at sea, and robbers on land. However, Oliver entered Rome in 1647, and was admitted to the Irish College. He was an excellent student and was ordained on January 1, 1654. Oliver remained in Rome, studied law and served as chaplain at Spienza University, ministered at Santo Spirito hospital, and cared for the poor and ill. By 1657 he was a professor of Theology and later of Apologetics or Controversies at Propaganda College.

The 1650s were a difficult time in for Catholics in Ireland, the majority of population, as Cromwell passed many penal laws against them, and the practice of Catholicism was banned. During this time Oliver was appointed by Irish bishops to be their agent in Rome. Following the Restoration of Monarchy, Pope Clement IX appointed Oliver Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of all Ireland 1669. Oliver returned to a country where the Catholic Church was in disarray and divided. He had to travel largely incognito and perform his duties in makeshift locations. He is credited with unifying the Church and in traveling across the eleven dioceses under his purview, confirming thousands, and ordaining several priests.

In 1673 persecution of Catholics was again on the rise and bishops were banned. Oliver went into hiding, but in 1679 he was arrested and charged with treason. He was hanged, drawn, and quartered at Tyburn in July 1681. Before his death he publicly forgave those responsible.

RENOVATION UPDATES

What has already happened?

- The small organ at the front of the Church has been removed to create space for a statue of the Blessed Disciple. The organ has been safely stored as we await a buyer to give it a new home.
- A small construction trailer has been placed by the port cochere. This will serve as the office and headquarters for our contractor and foreman during the renovation process. A small construction dumpster delivery is pending.

What's happening next?

- Temporary walls will soon be built at the front of the Church to contain the demolition and construction of the new niches for the Blessed Mother and Beloved Disciple statues. This will require a temporary change to the flow of the Communion Procession at Mass.
- The large organ in the back of the Church will be covered to protect it during the demolition process. We will use only the piano for a few weeks during the demolition.

NOVEDADES DE LA REMODELACION

Cambios que ya ocurrieron

- El pequeño órgano al frente de la Iglesia ha sido removido para crear espacio para una estatua del Discípulo Bendito. El órgano se ha almacenado de forma segura mientras esperamos que un comprador le dé un nuevo hogar.
- Se ha colocado un pequeño remolque de construcción junto al port cochere. Esto servirá como oficina y sede para nuestro contratista y capataz durante el proceso de renovación. Está pendiente la entrega de un contenedor de basura pequeño.

Cambios por venir

- Pronto se construirán paredes temporales en frente de la Iglesia para contener la demolición y la construcción de nuevas áreas para las estatuas de la Santísima Madre y el Discípulo Amado. Esto requerirá un cambio temporal en el flujo de la Procesión de la Comunión en la Misa.
- El órgano grande en la parte posterior de la Iglesia se cubrirá para protegerlo durante el proceso de demolición. Usaremos solo el piano durante unas semanas durante la demolición.

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Thank you for supporting the fellowship and service opportunities of the Women's Club, as well as the social needs of the parish. The Women's Club encourages all women of the parish to participate in service to the St. Cecilia Community. The **areas of service** are as follows:

The **Altar Guilds** are a 12 month ministry to help with light house cleaning in the Sanctuary and Chapel. Each volunteer and her Guild partner work 1 to 2 hours, **once or twice** during the year. Keeping God's house clean usually takes place on Fridays.

The **Good Neighbor Committee** is a 12 month ministry for planning and hosting funeral receptions. Volunteers can provide food and/or help with set-up, serving or clean-up afterward. Consider becoming a one-month chair.

The **Hospitality Committee** provides for light refreshments at Club general membership meetings. They also provide table décor and direct the set up and clean-up for Club's special lunches. No washing dishes on this Committee!

The **Program Committee** works as an advisory committee to the 1st Vice President – Programs to bring entertaining and unusual programs and events for our membership meetings.

The **Social Committee** has a two-fold focus. It helps organize and carry out special parish receptions such as for recognizing departing or retiring parish staff. The committee staffs the Club's Oktoberfest booth, proceeds of which go directly into the Oktoberfest coffers to reduce parish debt.

The **Communications Committee's** telephone tree and e-blast are the lifelines used to contact members about our events and with special announcements. Telephone callers contact those who do not have/use email.

The **Ways and Means Committee** is responsible for all fund-raising for the Club's discretionary use. The proceeds fund our scholarship for St. Cecilia School and other parish gifts. A raffle is held during the May off-site luncheon. May raffle proceeds go directly to Angela House.

*An **Associate membership** is available for members who are unable to actively participate in Club functions. (Bylaws, Article III)

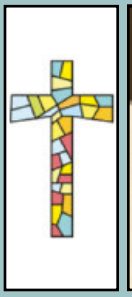
