Dear Parishioners:

---**The Feast of Jesus' Baptism** is the theme for this weekend Masses. With this Feast, we are officially ended the Christmas Season and it will lead us to the beginning of the **Ordinary Time** in the Liturgical Year. Through **Jesus' Baptism by John** in the muddy waters of the Jordan, he opens for us the possibility of accepting our human condition and of connecting with God. Jesus accepts the human condition and this includes: *suffering and death*. Jesus' baptism by John in the Jordan identifies him deeply with the people he has come to redeem.

This is the first brief part of the **Ordinary Time 2021** (*January 10th - February 16th*); then it resumes again (*June 24th - November 27th*) after the great seasons of **Lent and Easter**. The Ordinary Time is the period of time that we live out the Mystery that we have celebrated (*Emmanuel - God's with us*) and also anticipate the Mystery of the fullness of Christ's action - *The Life, Death and Resurrection*.

---The Feast of Jesus' Baptism also reminds us of **our own Baptism** and how we share this gift with others through the Church. There are two main ways to receive the Sacrament of Baptism:

1. The traditional Infant Baptism by the request of the Catholic parents.
2. The **R.C.I.A.** (**R**ite of **C**hristian **I**nitiation of **A**dult) or **R.C.I.C.** (**R**ite of **C**hristian **I**nitiation of **C**hildren "of catechetical age")


This Sunday evening and following, *our Junior High and High School aged young men and women* also begin a process of "**completing**" their own **Christian Initiation** that their parents have started for them since their birth with the *Sacrament of Baptism* and later on with the *Sacrament of Eucharist* in anticipating the **Sacrament of Confirmation** where they will speak of their total acceptance and commitments to live the Christian way of life.

The process of application has begun a few months ago but *it's not too late to register now*. If you have a daughter/son in Junior or Senior High School *who have not completed* their Christian Initiation with the Sacrament of Confirmation, please encourage them to sign up with Maria Murphree (*please see bulletin for further details*).

---**Next weekend January 16th & 17th**, at all Masses, we will be mentioned about the joy and happiness that many people had and continue to experience through the help of **C.C.S. (Catholic Community Services)**. Giving to C.C.S. makes a difference in people's lives here locally. There will be a special collection next weekend with envelopes provided. Please consider giving generously for this great cause as we continue to recognize the needs of many unfortunate people in our local area.

Questions of the Week: Reflect and Respond to Scripture

First Reading: Isaiah was called to be a prophet to bring justice and freedom to those suffering, to be a "light for the nations." How do you see yourself serving others in need in your life?

Second Reading: John teaches his community that God Himself has "testified on behalf of His Son." In what way does this divine assurance help strengthen your faith?

Gospel Question: The preaching of John the Baptist and the baptism of Jesus is the opening scene in the Gospel of Mark. In Jesus' baptism, the Father, Son, and Spirit were fully present. As a baptized Christian, can you think of a time when you experienced God's presence?



The Baptism of the Lord

This Sunday we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. "After Jesus was baptized, he came from the water and behold, the heavens were opened [for him], and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove [and] coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased'" (Mt 3: 16-17).

The feast of the Baptism of the Lord celebrates the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. We know that - since Jesus was born without sin - he did not really need to be baptized. And yet, Jesus welcomes his own baptism as an example for the rest of us and as a sign of his true identity. He is God's son, the living presence of God on earth. When we renew our baptismal promises, we proclaim our belief in the waters of baptism and our new and ongoing life in Christ.
