Dear Parishioners:

---As we come to worship God this weekend, we're fully remembered the Anniversary of September 11, 2001, most especially the 20th Anniversary of this horrific event. We lifted up those who have died *to the almighty God and ask our Risen Christ to remember His promise of "eternal life" to our deceased brothers and sisters* and healing for the surviving family's members. May the remembering of this anniversary event draw us closer together as a nation who *stand for freedom, liberty and justice* and as a faith community who always remembered *"the sacrifice of the victim of September 11th"*.

---**Congratulation Bishop Daniel Mueggenborg. 8th Bishop of the Diocese of Reno - Nevada on Friday, September 24, 2021.** A Farewell Mass for Bishop Mueggenborg **on Wednesday, September 8th, 12:10 PM at St. James Cathedral** is the final farewell to all the faithful as Bishop Mueggenborg moves to Reno. A number of parishioners were on a bus to his Ordination of Episcopacy at St. James Cathedral in Seattle 4 years ago. We give thanks to our God and Bishop Mueggenborg for his ministry here in our local Church and our prayers are with him as he will lead the Diocese of Reno.

---If there was ever a "turning point" in Mark's account of Jesus' public ministry, it is today's story (*Mark 8: 27-35*) is about affirmation, identity and purpose of Jesus' mission. Mark makes this episode the centerpiece of his gospel. It comes immediately after Jesus' healing of the blind man of Bethsaida.

The struggle to identify Jesus and his role as Messiah continues today. Some say individual Christians and the whole church should be **Elijah figures**, *publicly confronting systems, institutions and national policies*. That was the way Elijah saw his task. Some say, **like Jeremiah**, that the reign of Christ, through his Church, *is the personal and private side of life*. And there are indeed many who would like to reduce religion and faith to a private affair in our world today.

Jesus probes beyond both approaches and asks, "You, who do you say I am." In Peter's answer, "**You are Messiah**". The Messiah came into society, and into individual lives, in a total way, reconciling the distinction between public and private. *The quality of our response to this question is the best gauge of the quality of our discipleship*.

As Mary mothered Jesus, she is now mother to all his followers. Furthermore, as Jesus died, he handed over his Spirit. Mary and the Spirit cooperate in begetting new children of God—almost an echo of Luke's account of Jesus' conception. Christians can trust that they will continue to experience the caring presence of Mary and Jesus' Spirit throughout their lives and throughout history.

Benedict House Needs Meals In October

Our Parish Communities of St. Gabriel and Prince of Peace, serve meals for 30 days a year (2 weeks in March and 2 weeks in October) to single men who are in transition at Benedict House in Bremerton.

Our next session is October 1st - 15th. Are you a member of a group that would like to take a day (or two) to prepare a meal together? Please think about preparing and serving a meal to our neighbors in need.

When you sign up, you and your team are committing to buying the supplies (salad, main course and milk) to feed approximately 20 people (residents and staff), prepare the food at home and dropped off at Benedict House. Financial assistance is available if cost is an issue. Benedict House in Bremerton provides emergency beds for 24 single homeless men who are currently homeless in Kitsap County. The shelter also provides 3 additional respite beds for those needing time to recover after medical treatment. Volunteers from surrounding churches prepare the evening meal which is served in the commons dining room that also serves as a multi-purpose room for meetings and activities.

Benedict House necesita comidas en Octubre

Nuestras Comunidades Parroquiales de San Gabriel y Príncipe de Paz, sirven comidas durante 30 días al año (2 semanas en marzo y 2 semanas en octubre) a hombres solteros que están en transición en Benedict House en Bremerton.

Nuestra próxima sesión es del 1 al 15 de octubre. ¿Es usted miembro de un grupo que le gustaría tomar un día (o dos) para preparar una comida juntos? Por favor, piense en preparar y servir una comida a nuestros vecinos necesitados.

Cuando se inscribe, usted y su equipo se comprometen a comprar los suministros (ensalada, plato principal y leche) para alimentar a aproximadamente 20 personas (residentes y personal), preparar la comida en casa y dejarla en Benedict House. La asistencia financiera está disponible si el costo es un problema.

Benedict House en Bremerton proporciona camas de emergencia para 24 hombres solteros sin hogar que actualmente no tienen hogar en el condado de Kitsap. El refugio también proporciona 3 camas de relevo adicionales para aquellos que necesitan tiempo para recuperarse después del tratamiento médico. Los voluntarios de las iglesias circundantes preparan la cena que se sirve en el comedor común que también sirve como una sala de usos múltiples para reuniones y actividades.

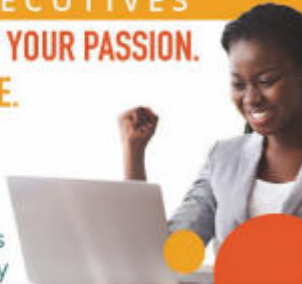
