Jesus is the key to it all

Are we willing to be taught by God? If we are, then we will begin to see things and make judgments using a Divine lens. Often, we perceive things with purely human eyes and reference points. When we do this, reality can lose its Divine spark and we miss what God is trying to say.

When using human eyes exclusively, Jesus is at best perceived simply as a prophet who has some wise things to say. The human element has a difficult time seeing Jesus' divinity and recognizing him as the Bread of Life that comes down from heaven. We can easily get stuck

on Jesus' human associations and overlook the marvelous wonders God wants us to see. If we really allow ourselves to be taught by God, we will then come to see the truth about Jesus and the abundant everlasting life God offers.

Jesus becomes the key that unlocks all of our relationships: with God, others, ourselves, and creation. He, as the true and lasting bread from heaven, shows us the gifts of faith, hope, and love that God bestows on us. Through this divine lens we see that all life sparkles and glows with God's love.

Gather Together as Disciples of Christ" at 6:30 p.m. It is going to be an evening of prayer and reflection. We plan to kick off 2021-2022 faith formation (family catechesis) during the weekend of August 22. Among other things the teachers or facilitators will be commissioned as catechist. Classes for First Holy Communion, Confirmation for youth, RCIC (Come and See) for older unbaptized children, youth and parents and RCIA adults will all be held in-person classes and planned to be held on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and on Sundays. If any family chooses to do faith formation online, please enroll in the program. We will also continue middle school Edge ministry.

August 16 will be the last day for Registration. I humbly ask all parishioners for their prayerful support. Kindly keep Faith formation/ Family Catechesis in your prayers.

All must wear masks to indoor gatherings

With the return of a Mask Mandate for many Nevada counties, Bishop Randolph Calvo has directed all persons, vaccinated or unvaccinated, must wear masks at all indoor gatherings. This Nevada Emergency Directive that went into effect on Friday, July 30 due to a substantial transmission of Covid-19. Washoe County is one of the affected counties.

The directive requires all persons to wear masks at public indoor gatherings. The new Diocese of Reno protocol, therefore, is that all persons, whether vaccinated or unvaccinated, wear masks when participating at indoor Masses and other liturgies and all indoor gatherings.

Calvo wrote the key to stopping the spread of Covid-19 is within reach: vaccination. He asked that parishioners who are not vaccinated to do so. Concern for one another's health and safety comes from Christ's command to love one another.

Cessation of Dispensation

Brothers and sisters in Christ,

At the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic, I granted to all Catholics in the Diocese of Reno a general dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass. Since there has been a significant decline in the number of cases, hospitalizations, and deaths due to the novel Coronavirus in our region, and given the lifting of mitigation restrictions, this dispensation will cease on July 1, 2021.

I encourage all Catholics to return to the practice of in-person participation in the Sunday Eucharist. The experience of the pandemic underscores the need for us to gather together physically for worship and the sacraments.

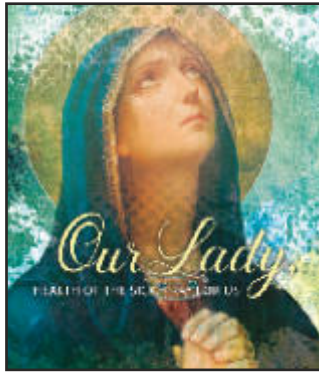

Family C atechesis is a faith formation model that is family, community (Eucharist and Word of God) and Christ centered. It is families celebrating their lives and faith with gratitude.

- A facilitator/teacher is a person of prayer (personal prayer life, participates in worship and is comfortable praying with the family).
- Is one who believes in prayer as the most transformative ministry in building up relationships and

fostering community.

- Is a person of relationship and is eager to learn the life and faith of the family.
- Is one who tries to identify with the family but at the same time is able to observe and take notes.
- Is respectful and attentive to the real situations for the family and be willing to walk with them.
- Is familiar and knowledgeable about the bible lessons, questions on faith and reflection points.
- Is one who is not inclined to teach but encouraging maximum sharing by the family.
- Is reliable, consistent and maintains very good communication with the family.
- Is desiring personal growth and ongoing formation.
- Is very prompt to answer question and will relay those questions unable to answer to the parish office immediately.
- Is creative.
- Is thankful.
- Is willing to spend at least one hour of their time/week.
- Is willing to join us for a monthly meetings.

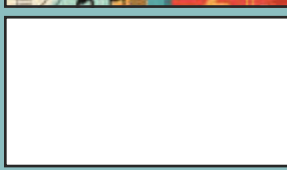
