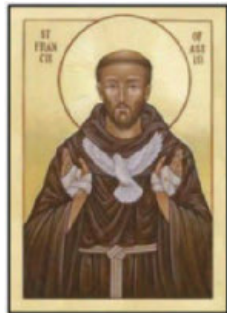


PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

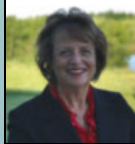
