





#### SYNODAL SURVEY

Bishop Joe Vásquez, in communion with Pope Francis, invites all the faithful to have their voices heard, leading up to the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, by completing the survey linked at www.austindiocese.org/synod-for-a-synodal-church. The survey will be available until Monday, Jan. 31, 2022. The questions center around the theme "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission." Once concluded, all responses will be compiled into a report and submitted to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The USCCB will then submit a national report for the General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in Rome. Please know the information raised during the consultation phase in our diocese will be reviewed and used for our own pastoral planning.

#### HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE


