OUR MISSION

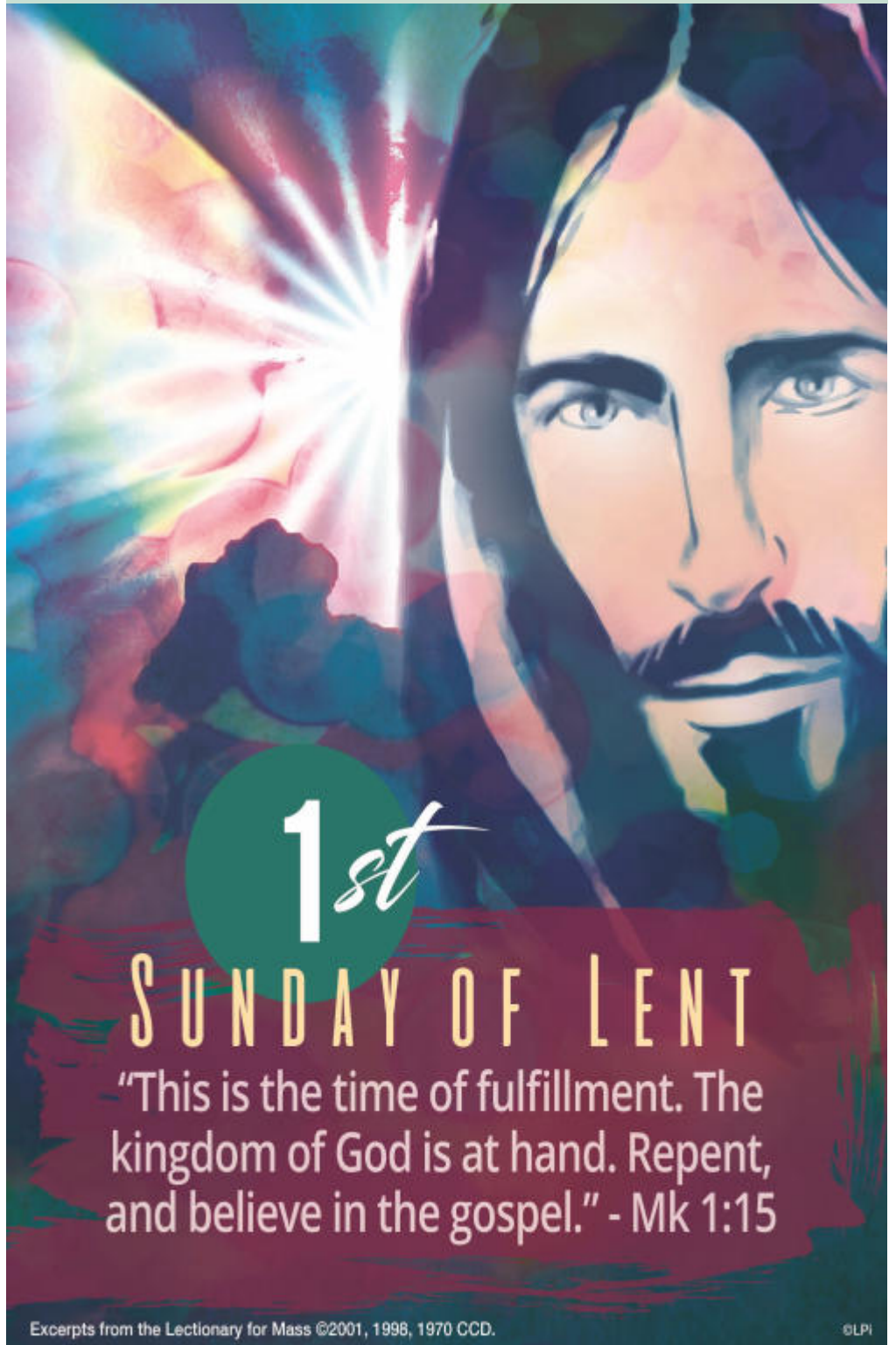
We gather in praise and worship of the Father, called by our baptism in Christ and living in His Spirit. Sent forth to embody the universal mission of the Catholic Church.

SECOND COLLECTIONS



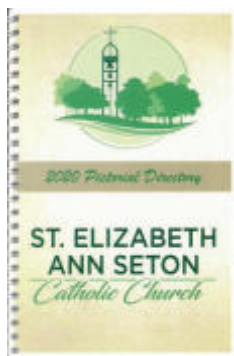

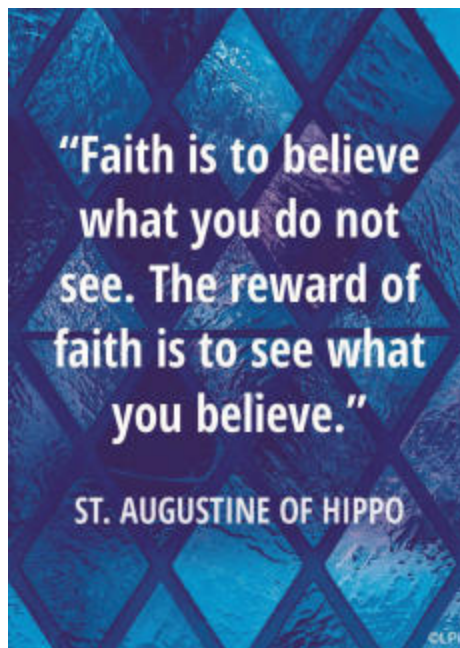
Diocesan Stewardship Appeal

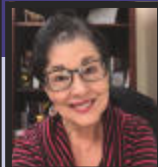

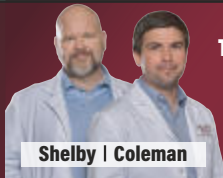
