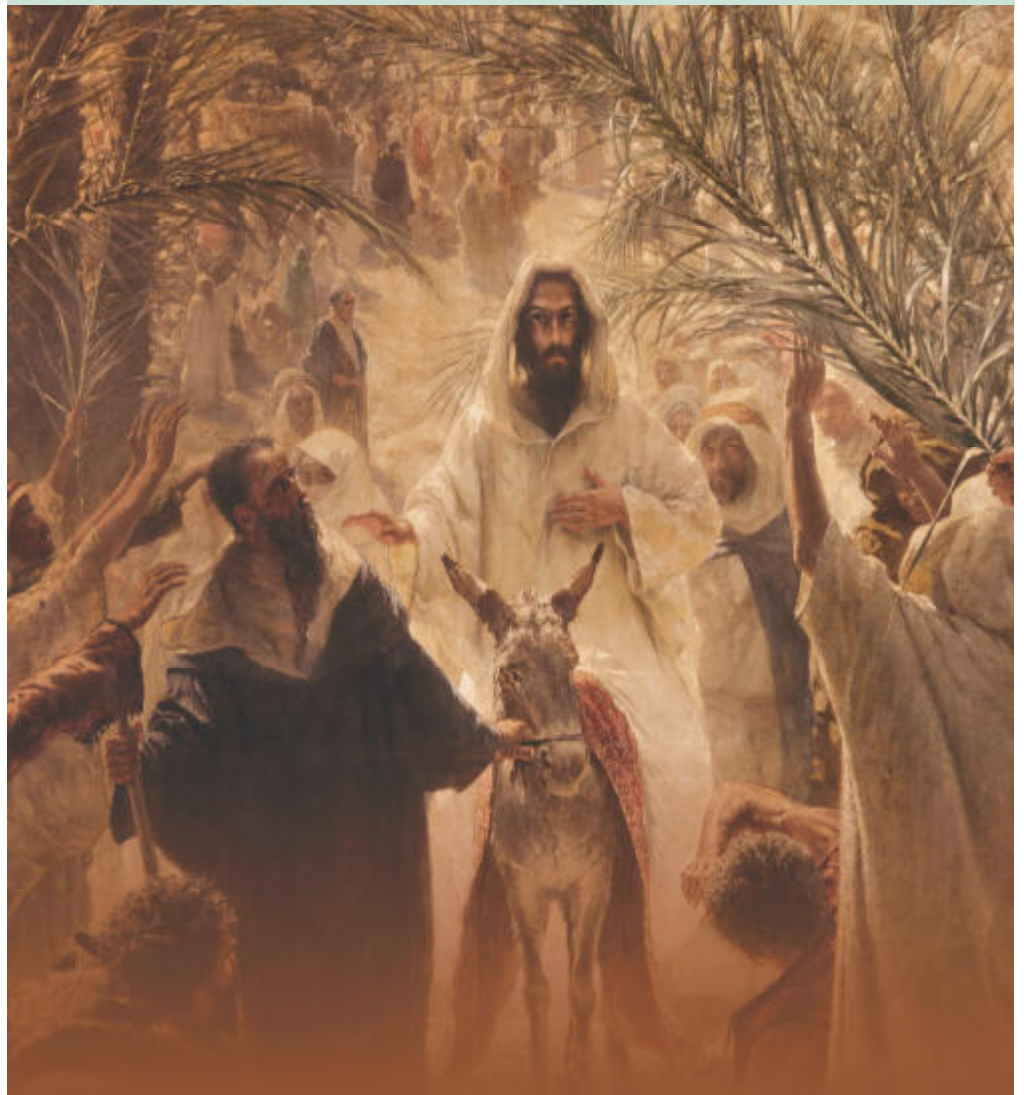
OUR MISSION

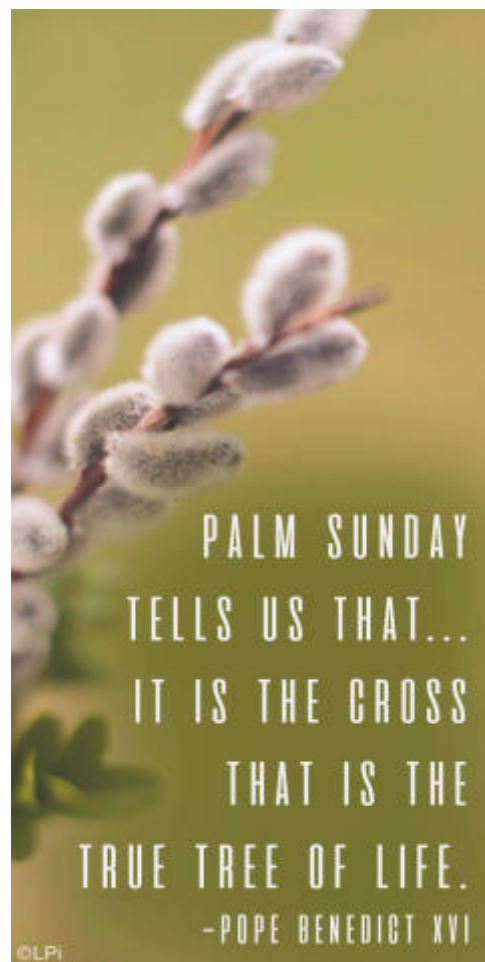

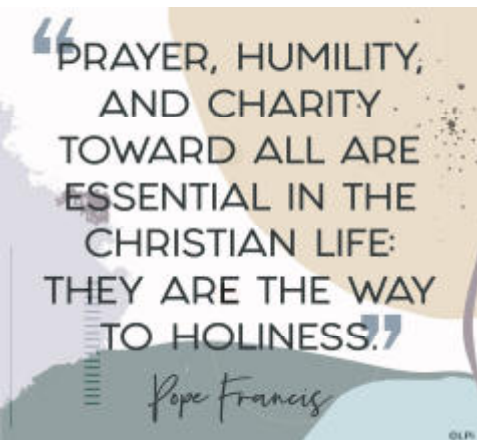
