HSC EASY RECIPES:

Chicken and Rice Dinner

(Serves 4)



- 1 tablespoon oil
- 4 small, boneless, skinless chicken breast halves
- 1 can condensed cream of chicken soup
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/2 cup chicken broth
- 2 cups Minute White Rice, uncooked
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder

Fresh parsley, chopped (optional)

Heat oil in large nonstick skillet on mediumhigh heat. Add chicken; cover. Cook 4 minutes on each side or until lightly browned on both sides. Remove chicken from skillet.

Add soup, water, and chicken broth to skillet; stir. Bring to boil.

Stir in rice, garlic powder, and onion powder.

Top with chicken; cover. Cook on low heat 5 minutes or until chicken is cooked through. (170 degrees). Let sit 5 minutes or until liquid is absorbed. Serve sprinkled with chopped parsley, if desired.

Substitute: For a whole-grain alternative, use Minute Brown Rice for the Minute White Rice and cook an additional 5 minutes.
