

Divine Mercy SUNDAY

The Corporal Works of Mercy

1. To visit the sick.
2. To feed the hungry.
3. To give drink to the thirsty.
4. To shelter the homeless.
5. To clothe the naked.
6. To visit the imprisoned.
7. To bury the dead.

The Spiritual Works of Mercy

1. To instruct the ignorant.
2. To counsel the doubtful.
3. To admonish sinners.
4. To forgive offenses willingly.
5. To comfort the afflicted.
6. To bear wrongs patiently.
7. To pray for the living and the dead.

The Message of the Divine Mercy that Sr. Faustina received from the Lord was not only directed toward her personal growth in faith but also toward the good of the people. With the command of our Lord to paint an image according to the pattern that Sr. Faustina had seen, came also a request to have this image venerated, first in the Sisters' chapel, and then throughout the world. The same is true with the revelations of the Chaplet. The Lord requested that this Chaplet be said not only by Sr. Faustina, but by others: "Encourage souls to say the Chaplet that I have given you."

The same is true of the revelation of the Feast of Mercy. "The Feast of Mercy emerged from my very depths of tenderness. It is my desire that it solemnly be celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the fount of My Mercy."

These requests of the Lord given to Sr. Faustina between 1931 and 1938 can be considered the beginning of the Divine Mercy Message and Devotion in the new forms.

However, it is important to remember that this message of The Divine Mercy, revealed to St. Faustina and to our present generation is not new. It is a powerful reminder of who God is and has been from the very beginning. This truth that God is in His very nature Love and Mercy Itself, is given to us by our Judeo-Christian faith and God's self-revelation. The veil that has hidden the mystery of God from eternity was lifted by God Himself. In His goodness and love God chose to reveal Himself to us, His creatures, and to make known His eternal plan of salvation. This He had done partly through the Old Testament Patriarchs, Moses and the Prophets, and fully through His only Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. In the person of Jesus Christ, conceived through power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary, the unseen God was made visible.

El Mensaje de la Divina Misericordia que sor Faustina recibió del Señor no solo estaba dirigido a su crecimiento personal en la fe, sino también al bien de la gente. Con el mandato de nuestro Señor de pintar una imagen según el patrón que había visto la Hna. Faustina, llegó también una solicitud para que esta imagen fuera venerada, primero en la capilla de las Hermanas y luego en todo el mundo. Lo mismo ocurre con las revelaciones de la Coronilla. El Señor pidió que esta Coronilla sea dicha no sólo por Sor Faustina, sino por otros: "Anima a las almas a rezar la Coronilla que te he dado".

Lo mismo ocurre con la revelación de la Fiesta de la Misericordia. "La Fiesta de la Misericordia surgió de lo más profundo de mi ternura. Es mi deseo que se celebre solemnemente el primer domingo después de Pascua. La humanidad no tendrá paz hasta que no se dirija a la fuente de Mi Misericordia".

Estas peticiones del Señor dadas a Sor Faustina entre 1931 y 1938 pueden considerarse el comienzo del Mensaje y la Devoción de la Divina Misericordia en las nuevas formas. Sin embargo, es importante recordar que este mensaje de la Divina Misericordia, revelado a santa Faustina y a nuestra generación actual, no es nuevo. Es un poderoso recordatorio de quién es y ha sido Dios desde el principio. Esta verdad de que Dios es en Su misma naturaleza Amor y Misericordia, nos es dada por nuestra fe judeocristiana y la autorrevelación de Dios. El velo que ha escondido el misterio de Dios desde la eternidad fue levantado por Dios mismo. En su bondad y amor, Dios decidió revelarse a nosotros, sus criaturas, y dar a conocer su plan eterno de salvación. Esto lo había hecho en parte a través de los Patriarcas del Antiguo Testamento, Moisés y los Profetas, y completamente a través de Su único Hijo, nuestro Señor Jesucristo. En la persona de Jesucristo, concebido por el poder del Espíritu Santo y nacido de la Virgen María, el Dios invisible se hizo visible.
