
Safety Alert!

Gospel Meditation

A Deeper Understanding of the Scripture



And to another he said, "Follow me." In every moment of every day, in every circumstance and experience, God is calling us. We can easily get distracted and not hear it or simply ignore it, pretending it wasn't even heard. When we do hear it and favorably respond, there are some conditions that must be met. Jesus makes it clear that once we say yes to his invitation, we must stay focused and forge ahead. We cannot keep looking behind or worry about unfinished business. There are some tasks, and discipleship is one, that require our full devotion.

There are many "masters" vying for our attention. We need something or someone to give us direction. Human nature requires it. Our motives and actions reveal what has our allegiance. It is tempting to give ourselves to masters that lure us with intriguing promises. When given the choice between a "master"

that promises worldly success, abundant wealth, status, privilege, and security versus a "master" that asks for self-sacrifice, hardship, suffering, ridicule, and death, to whom do we go? While the promise of immediate pleasure is enticing, there is always a catch.

For all that secular masters can promise, they always keep us looking behind, checking on ourselves, second guessing choices, calculating options, and being slaves to excessive worry.

Our guard can never come down. Only one master really promises life: Jesus Christ. Hearing his call, we either trust him or we don't.

Saying yes to following Christ does come with a risk. But it also comes with the brightness of future hopes and dreams. There is no need to keep looking behind. Sins are forgiven and regrets serve no effective purpose. God is not there. He's moved beyond all that stuff. God is in the today and the tomorrow and what he can continually do with our daily affirmation to follow Him. All we need to do is be obedient. St. Gianna Molla is credited with saying, "The stillness of prayer is the most essential condition for fruitful action. Before all else, the disciple kneels down." Begin with prayer. We will not only hear God's call but find the courage to trust that He will guide us where we need to be. God uses us in the most ordinary of ways through the simple daily expression of our lives.

When the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled, he resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem, and he sent messengers ahead of him.


On the way they entered a Samaritan village to prepare for his reception there, but they would not welcome him because the destination of his journey was Jerusalem.


When the disciples James and John saw this they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to consume them?"


A Special Request

Mission Haiti, Funding Report

We recently asked Doug Campbell and Fr. Tom where our donations were benefiting the people of Haiti. From the beginning of our relationship with Hands Together, we designated our funds as being unrestricted, meaning that Fr. Tom and Doug could spend the money wherever they felt was most critical at the time, i.e. projects or perhaps disaster relief in the form of food, water, shelter, medical aid. Throughout the years when traveling to Haiti, we were shown in person flourishing projects funded by Holy Family. Since we have been unable to travel to Haiti in the last number of years, Doug has provided us with an accounting of money



spent on the various projects. We will present this information over the next few weeks.

Hands Together recognizes the extraordinary support from Holy Family over the past 17 years. They have specifically dedicated several projects to the Holy Family community:

Monsignor Connolly School
Ti Desdunnes Holy Family School
Holtsnider Barefoot Kids Project
The Holy Family Bridge

Beginning with the Monsignor Connolly School (K - 6) in the Bellicou neighborhood of Cite Soleil, \$ 244,927 have been spent. This school is one of largest and most effectively run of all of the Hands Together schools. There are 850 students and 30 staff members. In addition, the elderly program held on campus feeds a daily meal and provides basic medical checks and care to 150 elderly people. This represents the largest percentage of your donations sent over the last year at 39 percent.



For over 30 years as a key member of our parish ministerial staff and 37 years as a parishioner, Frank Ponnet lived out the gospel call to discipleship. His death on July 7, 2021, left a void in our parish and in our hearts. Until a few weeks before his death when his health required that he step back, Frank was Holy Family's Director of Liturgy and Adult Education.

Over his years at Holy Family, he and his wife, Dawn, also served as directors of Christian Initiation (RCIA), Youth Ministry, and Remembering Church. Frank was the parish liaison to the Ecumenical Council of South Pasadena, and was committed to interfaith dialogue. He was a champion of the parish's social justice education and

outreach programs. He oversaw the training of Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors and Altar Servers. When members of our parish community lost loved ones and prepared for the church's final rites, Frank's consoling presence accompanied them through difficult days.

His ministry was marked by evangelizing, healing, teaching, reconciling, uniting, counseling and praying. A student of church history and the documents of the Second Vatican Council, Frank understood the church's human weaknesses, but he celebrated and was faithful to a church that is alive and open to growth. Frank embodied with his life the fullness of being true church, the fullness of being a true follower of Jesus Christ.




