#### SUMMER SKILLET

Place oil & potatoes in a large, non-stick skillet with a tight fitting lid on high heat; season with garlic powder, salt and pepper.

When it starts to sizzle, reduce heat to low and cook with lid on for about 20 minutes, shaking the pan occasionally to prevent potatoes from burning. Remove from heat and let sit for 5 minutes without removing lid, then set potatoes aside in a dish.

Add sausage to the skillet and saute on medium-low and cook, stirring occasionally until browned but not cooked through, about 10 minutes. Season chopped vegetables



with salt and pepper. Add onions, peppers, garlic and rosemary to the skillet and mix.

Stir occasionally, until onions & peppers become slightly browned. Add zucchini and cook 5 more minutes. Return potatoes to the skillet and mix well. Adjust salt & pepper. Cook 5 more minutes. Serve.

- · 2 tsp olive oil
- · 1 lb baby red potatoes (cut)
- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- 1 tsp salt
- · Pepper, to taste
- 14oz Italian chicken sausage
- · 1 large onion, chopped
- · 4 to 5 cloves garlic, smash
- 1/2 orange bell pepper, dice
- 1/2 yellow bell pepper, dice
- 1/2 red bell pepper, dice
- 2 TBSP fresh rosemary (or thyme)
- 2 cups zucchini (1/2" thick, quartered)
