





This year at Epiphany, participate in the Ancient Catholic tradition of Chalking the Doors.

The practice is called “chalking the doors” because priests traditionally would bless the house and then use chalk to write above the main entrance the specific year, separated by the letters C, M, and B (e.g., 20+C+M+B+22, for the 2022 blessing). The inscription is applied as a prayer that Christ will bless homes so marked and that he will stay with those who dwell there throughout the year and with any guest who may cross their threshold.

The letters stand for the Latin blessing, “*Christus Mansionem Benedicat* (May Christ Bless this House),” and the legendary names for the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar, most often seen symbolically to represent Asia, Europe, and Africa, respectively. As Scripture records, “the three, going into the house, saw the child with Mary, his mother, and they fell down and worshipped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold, frankincense, and myrrh (Matthew 2:11, RSV Catholic edition).”

The custom has fallen out of practice to the point where few know about it. We think “Chalking the Doors” is a tradition worth preserving. Blessed chalk will be available; after Masses to aid with the revival of this God-centered practice.

How to Participate

Using chalk, write on the outside of your house or inside above the front main entrance, above or next to an entrance:

+20 Christus Mansionem Benedicat 22+ or 20+C+M+B+22

Pray: Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who live here and all who visit. May we be blessed with health, kindness of heart, gentleness, and the keeping of your law. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our love for each other may go out to all. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

From Bishop Thanh

Today we celebrate the feast of Epiphany. Epiphany means revelation, a direction for our search. In the Gospel of Luke, we have the poor searching in the form of the shepherds. In the Gospel of Mathew, we have the rich and learned searching in the form of Magi.

The Magi are three searchers who did not find the answer to life in their horoscopes but took a long and difficult journey to another country in search of the Christ Child. There was a risk: the risk of inquiry “Who knew what they might learn?” The risk of the journey “Who knew what they might meet?” The risk of search “Who knew what they might find?”

That is the story of Matthew, but what about you and me? Where do we fit into this Gospel story of Epiphany? First, we are part of the community. No one on earth can successfully journey alone. We need each other’s balance, guidance, and encouragement. We are journeying together.

Second, we are in different spaces on this journey. Some of us are way up in front, and some of us are in the rear. Some of us are willing, and some are dragging their feet. Some of us journey with great certainty, and some journey with great doubt. Some of us are veteran seekers, and some of us are newcomers.

No matter, the important thing is that we are on a journey. We are responding to the Gospel. We are taking a risk, and that’s the best part of the Epiphany. Those among us who are vigorous can support those who are tired and discouraged, and that’s the best part of what we call community.

This is Epiphany time, revelation time. Keep journeying together with a spirit of interdependence. There is an Epiphany’s promise:

Wherever we are in this journey, we will, every one of us, reach the goal of the journey; that is, we too will look into the face of the Messiah.

Este año en la Epifanía, participe en la Antigua Tradición Católica de marcar las Puertas con Gis.

La práctica se llama "marcar las puertas con gis" porque los sacerdotes tradicionalmente bendecían la casa y luego usaban gis para escribir sobre la entrada principal el año específico, separados por las letras C, M y B (por ejemplo, 20 + C + M + B +22, para la bendición del 2022). La inscripción se aplica como oración para que Cristo bendiga los hogares marcados y se quede con los que allí habitan durante todo el año y con cualquier huésped que cruce su entrada.



Las letras representan la bendición latina, "Christus Mansionem Benedicat (Que Cristo bendiga esta casa)", y los nombres legendarios de los tres magos: Gaspar, Melchor y Baltasar que se ven más a menudo simbólicamente para representar a Asia, Europa y África respectivamente. Como registra la Escritura, "los tres, entrando a la casa, vieron al niño con María, su madre, y se postraron y lo adoraron. Luego, abriendo sus tesoros, le ofrecieron regalos: oro, incienso y mirra (Mateo 2:11, edición católica RSV) ".

La costumbre ha perdido hasta el punto de que pocos la conocen. Creemos que "Marcando las Puestas" es una tradición que vale la pena conservar. Habrá gis bendecido disponible; después de las misas para ayudar con el reavivamiento de esta práctica centrada en Dios.

Como participar

Con el gis, escriba en el exterior de su casa o en el interior sobre la entrada principal, arriba o al lado de una entrada una de las dos opciones:

Opción 1: +20 Christus Mansionem Benedicat 22+

Opción 2: 20+C+M+B+22

Ore: Señor Dios del cielo y de la tierra, revelaste a tu Hijo unigénito a cada nación con la guía de una estrella. Bendice esta casa y a todos los que viven aquí y a todos los que la visitan. Que seamos bendecidos con salud, bondad de corazón, mansedumbre y el cumplimiento de tu ley. Llénanos de la luz de Cristo, para que nuestro amor mutuo se extienda a todos. Te lo pedimos por Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén.




The Chaplet of Divine Mercy


