

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION FROM DEACON TERRY

Some years ago, milk producers came up with the catchy slogan, "Milk, it does a body good!" In each of today's readings, we could say something similar; "Gratitude, it does a body good!" Medical professionals tell us being grateful is good for our health. Naaman, a gentile, is so grateful for the return of his health, he asks for two mule-loads of earth to take home to give thanks and praise God. St. Paul says to give thanks in all circumstances and Jesus affirms the faith of the Samaritan leper who is the only one to return and give thanks to God. Even though scholars can't quite seem to agree or don't know why the other nine, who were Jewish, chose not to return or whether they may have even returned later, we do know for sure that the Samaritan, the foreigner, returned immediately to give glory and praise to God. This tells us while all ten were cleansed, only one was saved by his faith. Surprise?



We also hear in our readings the emphasis on both Naaman and the Samaritan as foreigners, meaning they were outsiders. Despite their outsider status, not to mention their leprosy, we find in the case of Naaman it was his obedience to Elisha, God's messenger, and in the case of the Samaritan it was his faith that mattered most. So, by today's standards, whom do we see as outsiders? Where or in whom have we been surprised to find God present? How often do we turn to Jesus to give glory to God because we are grateful for what God has done not only for us, but for others too? May our minds and hearts be open, and not surprised, at who models faith in God's saving love. Just like in our Old Testament and Gospel readings, obedience and faith can and should open our eyes and lead us to be grateful to see God where we might least expect. Let us always be grateful whenever, wherever, and in whomever we see the gift of faith in God manifested. Faith cannot be claimed or chained by who we consider to be in or out. Let us allow the Holy Spirit to nurture a growing attitude of gratitude within us so life grows rich and more meaningful for us all. Gratitude is good. Gratitude is healthy. Amen!






