Dear Parishioners and Friends of SEAS,

2026 CATHOLIC STEWARDSHIP APPEAL: "In the One Christ, we are one"

Pope Leo XIV reminds us of our unity in Christ, and how important it is for us to live as one family of faith. Here in our Archdiocese of Las Vegas, we are reminded of our unity as this local church. We are not just a gathering of 38 individual parishes and missions, but we are one family of faith celebrating our unity within our diversity!

As this family of faith, we are called to help support the works of this Archdiocese through our cooperation in the 2026 Catholic Stewardship Appeal (CSA). It's no coincidence that our kick-off weekend coincided with the Gospel reading of the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-12a). The Be-attitudes guide us as fellow disciples along the way. We don't look for our rewards in the here-and-now, but are promised that our "reward will be great in heaven."

So the question I put to those at the 8AM Mass last weekend was: What is our "attitude" toward the annual CSA? Do we look at the CSA as a privilege to support the good works of our Archdiocese? Or do we look at the CSA as a burden to ignore? For the approximately 789 of our 6,000+ registered households (as of January 15th, 2026), your active participation was seen as a privilege! Thank you for making last year's 2025 CSA such a huge success!

For the remaining 5,200 registered households who did not participate last year for a variety of reasons, will you consider making CSA 2026 a new beginning of privileged support? Remember, no gift is too large or too small when given with a grateful heart! While we, as a parish family, contributed the most of all parishes in the Archdiocese of Las Vegas for CSA 2025 (of which we are so very

grateful!), imagine what we could have done if everyone got on board! If every one of those 5,200+ households gave an average of \$100 for the year (less than \$10 per month!), we would have received a rebate of over \$520,000! Remember, every dollar beyond our goal is rebated back to our parish. As has been the practice for many years, our rebates will continue to be applied to the eventual renewal of our worship space!

And so, as a registered parishioner of SEAS myself, I contributed during the 8AM Mass last week from my cell phone. It really was quite easy. As your pastor I need to lead by example, so I made my contribution to the 2026 CSA of \$1,000. I don't share this to brag, but to hopefully encourage your own attitude to give, if possible, 1% or one penny of every dollar earned. As a reminder, the concept of Christian Stewardship invites us to prayerfully consider the following percentages of our annual income as follows: 5% to our parish first collections, 4% to the charities of our own choice, and 1% to the support of our Archdiocese. That means that 90% of our income remains for us to support our individual and/or family needs. God will not be outdone in generosity!

So, that's enough for my annual encouragement to embrace a "be" attitude of privilege to support the 2026 CSA. May God continue to bless those of you whose giving is a privilege and who continue to recognize that "In the One Christ, we are one!"

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LIVE THE LITURGY

Salt without flavor is no longer salt. Light that illuminates nothing is no longer light. As Christians, we must be what we have been made to be. So think about it, carefully: what stands between you and being who you were made to be?

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VIRTUES EXPLAINED

Goodness, *Explained*

In the beginning, goodness was all there was. And in the end, only goodness will remain.

The word "good" is repeated so often in the first verses of Genesis that it has become almost cliché. God sees what He has made, and He calls all of it "good" (Genesis 1:31). Likewise, on the very first page of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, we read that God created man "in a plan of sheer goodness ... to make him share in his own blessed life." (CCC 1). When we see goodness, we cannot help but think of God (Wisdom 13:1).

In baptism, the Holy Spirit gives us the sanctifying grace of justification, which is, among other things, the ability to grow in goodness through an increase in moral virtue (CCC 1266). Baptism, therefore, disposes us toward goodness, and the more we ask the Holy Spirit for goodness, the more it will be possible for us.

WORSHIP & MEDITATION

LITURGY GOSPEL MEDITATIONS

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time — Matthew 5:13-16

I recently learned why zebras have stripes. Scientists used to think it was for camouflage, but new research suggests something more interesting: the stripes help zebras blend in with one another. When a predator looks at a herd, the overlapping stripes make it hard to single out one animal. But if a researcher spray-paints a dot on just one zebra, predators lock on it and eventually attack. The lesson? In the wild, blending in is protection. Standing out can be dangerous.

Human beings are not so different. Most of us would rather blend in than stand out, especially when it comes to our faith. We know that giving bold witness to Jesus — through our words, values, or public choices — can make us targets for criticism, isolation, or judgment. That's why Jesus' words in today's Gospel are so challenging: **"You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden" (Matthew 5:14).**

A city on a hill draws attention. It also draws fire. But that's part of the cost of discipleship. Jesus doesn't call us to be tribal or boastful. He calls us to stand in the open with humble confidence, so that people might see our good deeds and glorify our Father in heaven. Today, let's ask for the courage not just to believe in Christ, but to be seen believing in him.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? — CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question: Are near-death experiences real?

Answer: There is a lot of curiosity and fascination with the idea of an afterlife and communicating with those who have died. In movies, television shows, and numerous books, people make claims about their ability to communicate with the dead, or having had a near-death experience. There is no objective way to verify any of this. While details about people and events can be surprisingly accurate, it is just circumstantial evidence that might be explained in other ways.

On the other hand, when people have unusual experiences, sometimes called near-death or out-of-body, it is real to them. They react with the emotions and thoughts that one would expect. At times, they report details they could not have known any other way, such as bits of conversation, or meeting people they had never known in this life. So certainly, to the person, they experience something. We believe in a life after death, we believe in the communion of saints. These things are not a contradiction to faith, but we should not base our faith on them, nor change our beliefs. They are unexplained and will likely remain so.

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PRACTICING CATHOLIC

Be Salty

I want you to close your eyes. Are they closed? (I’m serious.) Okay. Now think of the greatest saint in history.

I don’t care who you’re thinking of. It’s going to be different for everyone. Just think of that person. Think of his or her life. And answer the question: Why is he or she a great saint? You’re all thinking of different people, but the answer is the same for everyone. And it’s not “Because he did great things for God” or “Because she sacrificed everything she had for the poor.” Those answers show evidence of the reason. But the reason is something more.

The greatest saints in history were not great at holiness. God brought holiness about within them because (ding ding ding! Here’s the answer!) the greatest saints in history were great at being who they were meant to be. Not who they wanted to be. Not who they thought they should be. Who they were meant to be. Simply put, they gave themselves to God. All of themselves. Flaws and all. And God took them, in their totality, and said: “Now watch this.”

Just imagine if salt was ashamed of being salty. Imagine if it looked at the sodium content on its nutrition label and thought, “That’s embarrassing,” and decided it was going to stop being salt. Well, great. Now it’s just a box of tiny rocks. Wouldn’t it have been better for the salt to trust the baker using it?

There is a plan for each of us. There is a path to holiness for each of us. This path doesn’t bypass our flaws or our weaknesses; it incorporates them. It transforms them. It fulfills them.

So be salty. Be who you were meant to be.

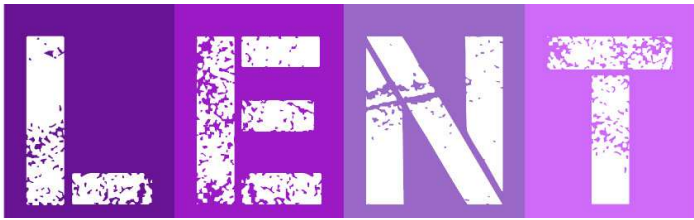
