



The third and final section of Luke's Sermon on the Plain begins: And he told them a parable. There are actually four parables, three of which we read today. They are all about how to be a good disciple.

The blind cannot lead the blind. And a disciple cannot be a good disciple unless he or she has learned from the teacher. Everyone who is fully trained is like the teacher who knows how to cure the blind. Before you can be a good disciple and teach others you must take care of yourself. Do not try to take a speck out of your brother's eye until you have taken the board out of your own. Finally, only when you have purified yourself can you produce the good works that the teacher requires. Discipleship asks us to produce good deeds. But to produce them requires the integrity and purity of heart found in the teacher. When people see your good deeds they will know that this is because you have a good heart.

The final parable, which we do not read today, is about building on the solid foundation of rock and not on sand. This is the only way to face the difficulties a disciple will encounter and survive.

## **GUIDELINES FOR LENTEN OBSERVANCE**

**Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022.** It signals the beginning of the penitential season leading up to Palm Sunday the beginning of Holy Week. Everyone is encouraged to attend daily Mass, receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attend the Stations of the Cross, engage in works of charity and justice, and undertake acts of self-denial.

The following are the guidelines of Lenten observance:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

Fasting binds all persons who have completed their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday through those who have completed their 59<sup>th</sup> year, unless prevented by poor health.

On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to one's own needs.

Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence binds all persons who have completed their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday, unless prevented by poor health. On days of abstinence, the consumption of meat is not allowed. The Church strongly encourages the observance of Friday abstinence, but failure to do so is not regarded as sinful.
