





## ALL FOR THE CLORYOF GOD

Dear Parish Family,

On the weekend of February 19–20<sup>th</sup>, our parish was introduced to our annual DSF appeal. At all Masses, a video from Daniel Cardinal DiNardo was shown to emphasize a fraction of the ministries that serve our growing Archdiocese of Galveston–Houston. Our archdiocese has 153 parishes and missions and is made up of 1.7 million Catholics.

For 2022, the assessed financial goal to our parish is \$347,821. I am pleased to report that this is a significant decrease from our previous goal of \$405,000—a goal that we had carried since 2016. I thank all of you who have made your pledge to DSF 2022. If you have not, I kindly ask you to consider doing so at this time. If you are able, make a pledge of at least \$1.00 per day or, \$365 per annum. If you are able to give a larger pledge, both the archdiocese and I are thankful for your gift.

It is my desire that the number of people who make a pledge continue to increase each year. In this way, greater participation allows more disciples to be part of the mission of our local church. This year, the archdiocese has introduced incentives, new to us, that can assist in discerning "how" you might participate. The new incentives are as follows: a 100% rebate on every dollar a parish raises over goal will come back to our parish; next, a 50% rebate on the total amount given by first time DFS donors; additionally, the parish in each vicariate with the greatest increase in participation over

DSF 2021 will receive a \$5,000 check at the DSF Vicariate meeting; and finally, winners from these \$5,000 incentives are tax-free for the purpose of calculating Cathedraticum taxes for all parishes. In other words, we will "not" have to pay tax to the archdiocese on the \$5,000.

The aforementioned provides all parishes, including ours, greater reasons for contributing to DSF and assisting our parish to reach its goal. When we all come together as one, we are indeed very strong in providing for the financial resources needed to operate the varied ministries and departments that so many have come to rely on.

Once again, I thank you for your continued support and generosity to both our local church of Galveston-Houston and to St. Michael the Archangel Church. May God continue to bless us, one and all! Saint Michael the Archangel, pray for us!


