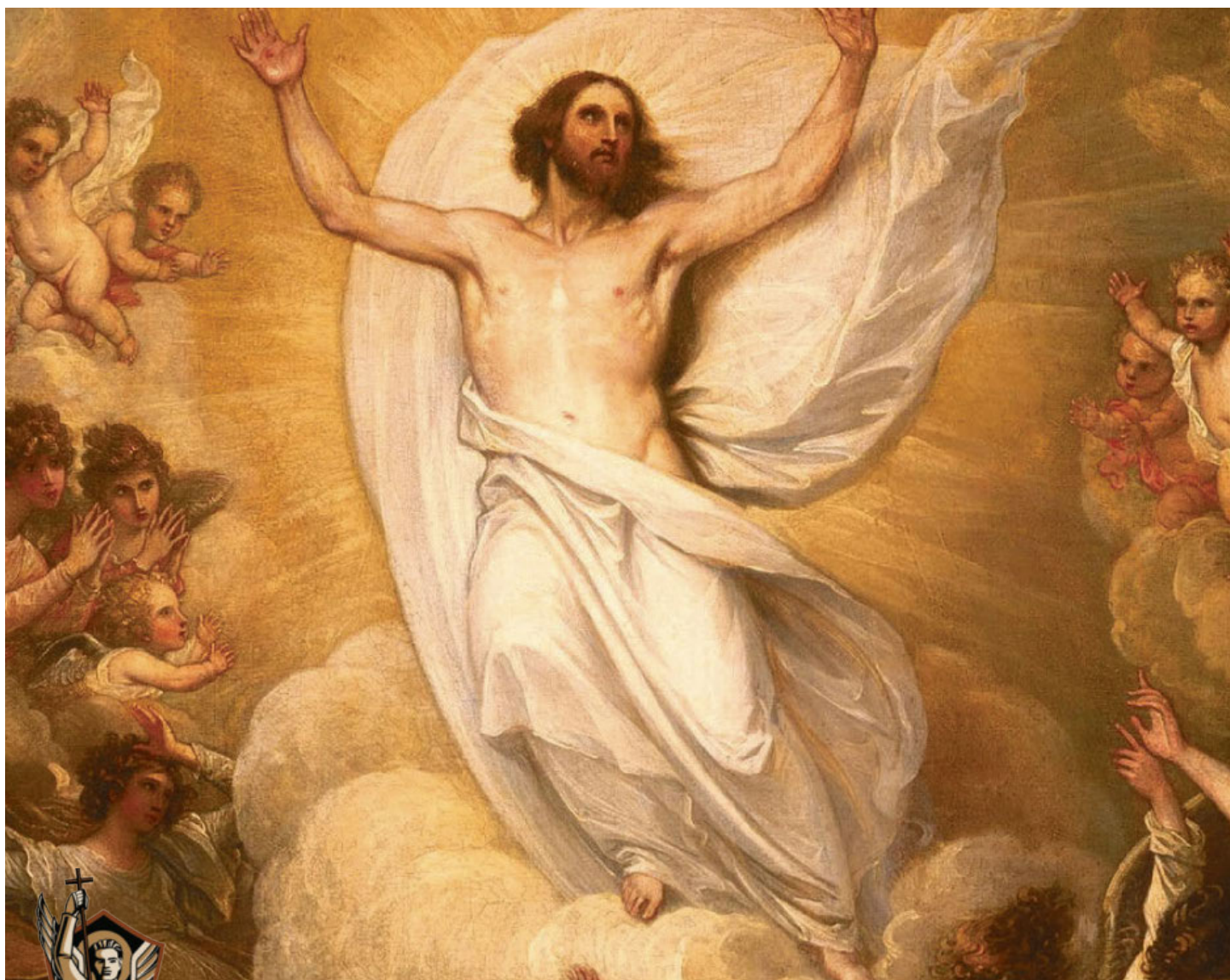

Dear Parish Family,
