



### PROPER ATTIRE AND CONDUCT IN CHURCH

There is an increase in the number of people who come for a visit to church, attend Mass, or devotional prayer who are dressed in a way that is not respectful of the sacredness of the church and liturgical celebrations. This is especially true during the summer months.

What we wear and how we act says a great deal about the importance of the event we are attending and what and who we value. The Mass (including daily Mass) is a very special time no matter the day, "a great and holy moment", and proper dress is a witness of our belief and reverence for our Lord's presence in the Eucharist and respect for the assembly who gathers with us to pray.

Men, women, and children should not wear tank tops, t-shirts with inappropriate logos or writing, shorts or flip-flops.

Please note that women <u>should not</u> wear spaghettistrap tops, halter tops and halter dresses, backless tops and dresses, short skirts, shorts or tops with plunging necklines or tights without a long cover top. Simply put—picnic, casual outdoor sports wear, beach wear, lounge wear, etcetera <u>are not appropriate attire in church</u>.

A minister for the liturgy especially should dress with extra care so that your appearance denotes

the dignity of worship and the honor and privilege of serving at Mass.

During liturgies (Mass) the narthex is a "quiet zone". Food and drinks, talking on cell phones in the church or narthex is not allowed as it is a distraction to those who wish to hear the Mass and pray. Parents are requested to keep the children from running in the narthex. It is not safe for the child. Once you enter the nave of the church everyone is asked to maintain quiet and respectful conversation.

It is certainly not our desire to be unwelcoming to all who come each day to pray and worship the Lord. We do request that our posture and appearance recognize, and bears witness to the essence of our faith which is the presence of Christ, Jesus, truly in our midst. Thank you for *Your* witness to *Whom* it is who invites us into His house of prayer!

"Bodily demeanor (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of the moment when Christ becomes our guest." Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1387b

# A Message from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

As spring literally "melts" into summer, we find ourselves embracing vacations and much needed time spent with family. Now that school has officially ended, it is my prayer that you take time and enjoy the blessings that God gives us as His people. As more families will choose to spend summertime with "staycations," the true gift is in spending time with those whom we love. Heavy on my heart and the hearts of many is the tragic massacre of innocent children and lives at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas. Let us unite and pray without ceasing for the families and lives that have been shattered—forever changed and in deep need of healing, understanding, and peace. As a result of this sadness, I have had several parishioners approach me and ask a question: "Fr. Wayne, is it possible to provide additional security for the church during our weekend Masses?" Oftentimes questions are posed to me, but two individuals also said: "What do you think about taking up a collection so that we as a parish community can help to offset this needed and unbudgeted expense?" I truly appreciate not only the question but also, the solution. I am working with our parish bookkeeper to amend our budget and increase our security budget—which is already, a significant budgeted need for our parish and campus. That said, I will be asking for those of you who are concerned with the safety and security of all who attend Masses at St. Michael the Archangel to please contribute generously to this needed expenditure. I must admit, it is indeed sad that we have to make such accommodations but the safety and security of each person who attends Masses at our parish is paramount. It is my desire to have a minimum of two police officers at every Mass. As well, we will continue to employ the following

procedures at Saturday and Sunday Masses: As soon as Mass begins, all doors to the church and transept of the church, excluding the main narthex, will be locked from the outside. Our doors will be able to be opened freely and easily from the interior—posing no risk or danger if an emergency occurs in the church and parishioners need to exit quickly. I will ask that one of our police officers stay in the main narthex at all times while the second police officer will patrol the parking lots and church property. I kindly ask that EVERYONE participate in noting exits in the church and be mindful and watchful of any person that you feel exhibits suspicious behavior. With additional training, we will make certain that our ushers will be alert and at the ready to assist in any way—in any situation. In a word, let us take care of one another—we ARE our brother and sister's keepers. With the violence that has occurred at a Baptist Church in Sutherland Springs, a Jewish Synagogue in the North Dallas Metroplex and Santa Fe, Texas, and now, in Uvalde, Texas, we must be vigilant while at the same time being focused on our need to pray and worship at Mass-now more than ever. YOU remain my top priority and in this effort I need your help. Finally, we need to increase the number of ushers that currently serve at St. Michael the Archangel. I ask you to please search your hearts and see if you are willing to join this ministry to assist us at our weekend liturgies. You may contribute as you always have to our parish but write "SM Security" in the memo column of your check or note this in your on-line gifting.






