

I recently had the opportunity to lead a pilgrimage to Germany, Austria, and Switzerland. Many from our parish joined me in this wonderful trip to see the "Passion Play" in Oberammergau, Germany. As pilgrims, we enjoyed many beautiful sights and had the opportunity to celebrate daily Mass.

# A MESSAGE FROM FR. PETER WOOD

Dear Parishioners,

I was very happy when I learned my new assignment would be St. Michael the Archangel Catholic Church. I look forward to being here, getting to know all of you and being a part of things. I am coming from St James the Apostle Church in Spring where I have served for several years in various capacities. Father Wayne has asked me to write a short biography.

I was raised in an Air Force family, the middle of three sons. We lived in many places. In fact, I was born in Nagoya, Japan. We also lived in New York, Alabama and Washington DC. Then with my father's retirement from the Air Force, we moved to Florida around the time I was entering high school. Later, regarding my college education, I majored in American Studies at Florida State University in Tallahassee, Florida, philosophy and pre theology at the Pontifical College Josephinum, Worthington, Ohio, and four years of theology at The Catholic University of America, Washington DC along with some theology courses at St. Thomas School of Theology here in Houston. I also earned four units of Clinical Pastoral Education as a Chaplain Resident at CHI St. Luke's in the Houston Medical Center.

My career activity has included, in addition to priesthood, Catholic education as a high school religion teacher and coach in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and in Jacksonville, Florida, and middle school religion teacher, teaching 6th, 7th, and 8th grade in Jacksonville. I have also taught faith formation in parishes to both youth and adults.

My parents are deceased. In fact, both are buried in Arlington National Cemetery in

Washington DC. The burial ceremonies the military performs, in accompaniment with the Catholic funeral rites, are indeed moving, inspiring and unforgettable.

My oldest brother, Ned, lives in South Carolina and served in the Army. My youngest brother, Chris, lives up the road in Spring. Both my brothers entered the corporate world. I gravitated toward the priesthood.

My family calls me Uncle-Brother-Father Pete- my two brothers having had three daughters each, and now their daughters with their own children. Additionally, I found out somewhat recently, a high school friend, who raises and trains horses, named one of her horses Father Pete. But I don't think the horse won the Kentucky Derby or anything.

I have had a life long love of sports and played sports myself through the years: football, basketball, baseball and golf. I notice there is an exercise machine in the rectory. I hope to use it and may even occasionally play some golf.

But, mainly, I am here for all of you as one of your priests. I very much look forward to working with Father Wayne and all of you. And since, Father Tom Rafferty is in residence at our rectory I can already say that we three priests get along very well.

I'll be praying for all of you. Please pray for me. And together, under the leadership of Father Wayne, let us serve the Lord and build up the Kingdom of God.





As such, we request your attendance at all of our meetings and please notify the office of adult formation if you are unable to attend a specific meeting and schedule a time to make up the missed session.
