



Luke gives more attention to Jesus' teachings on prayer than any other Gospel writer. He also mentions Jesus at prayer more than the others. In today's reading, from the beginning of Chapter 11 of his Gospel, Luke presents the core of Jesus' teaching on prayer. It consists of Jesus teaching a prayer to his disciples, a parable on the persistent neighbor, and assurances that God hears our prayers.

The disciples notice lesus praying "in a certain place." They ask him to teach them to pray just as John the Baptist had taught his disciples. Jesus teaches them a simple version of the most famous Christian prayer, the Our Father, or the Lord's Prayer. Matthew's version shows signs of being shaped by public prayer. Luke's version is probably closer to the original form that Jesus taught. Stripped of much of the language we are used to, Luke's version seems simple and direct. We pray that God's name will be recognized as holy and that his rule over all will be established. This is followed by petitions for our needs for bread, for forgiveness, and for deliverance. Luke uses the more theological language of "sins" rather than "debts," which is used in Matthew's version.

Having taught his disciples a simple, daily prayer, Jesus goes on to reassure them that God answers prayers. First he tells a parable about a persistent neighbor who asks a friend for bread at midnight. The friend is already in bed and has no desire to disturb his family by opening the door. But because the neighbor is persistent, the sleeping man gets up and gives him all that he needs. If a neighbor is willing to help us if we are persistent enough, how could God not respond to our requests?

This teaching concludes with the reminder that if we seek, we will get a response. If a human father, with all his faults, knows how to give good gifts to his children, how much more will our heavenly Father give us? Instead of good gifts, however, Luke substitutes the word Holy Spirit. This foreshadows the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is central to Luke's theology and who will play an important role in the growth of the early Church after Pentecost.

The parable and the concluding teaching in this section should not lead us to think of prayer as a series of requests presented to God. Rather, as Jesus teaches in his model prayer, prayer consists in recognizing God's holiness and his rule over all things.

PROPER ATTIRE AND CONDUCT IN CHURCH

There is an increase in the number of people who come for a visit to church, attend Mass, or devotional prayer who are dressed in a way that is not respectful of the sacredness of the church and liturgical celebrations. This is especially true during the summer months.

What we wear and how we act says a great deal about the importance of the event we are attending and what and who we value. The Mass (including daily Mass) is a very special time no matter the day, "a great and holy moment", and proper dress is a witness of our belief and reverence for our Lord's presence in the Eucharist and respect for the assembly who gathers with us to pray.

Men, women, and children should not wear tank tops, t-shirts with inappropriate logos or writing, shorts or flip-flops.

Please note that women <u>should not</u> wear spaghettistrap tops, halter tops and halter dresses, backless tops and dresses, short skirts, shorts or tops with plunging necklines or tights without a long cover top. Simply put—picnic, casual outdoor sports wear, beach wear, lounge wear, etcetera <u>are not</u> <u>appropriate attire in church</u>.


A minister for the liturgy especially should dress with extra care so that your appearance denotes the dignity of worship and the honor and privilege of serving at Mass.

During liturgies (Mass) the narthex is a "quiet zone". Food and drinks, talking on cell phones in the church or narthex is not allowed as it is a distraction to those who wish to hear the Mass and pray. Parents are requested to keep the children from running in the narthex. It is not safe for the child. Once you enter the nave of the church everyone is asked to maintain quiet and respectful conversation.

It is certainly not our desire to be unwelcoming to all who come each day to pray and worship the Lord. We do request that our posture and appearance recognize, and bears witness to the essence of our faith which is the presence of Christ, Jesus, truly in our midst. Thank you for *Your* witness to *Whom* it is who invites us into His house of prayer!

"Bodily demeanor (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of the moment when Christ becomes our guest." Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1387b
