GUIDELINES FOR LENTEN OBSERVANCE

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023. It signals the beginning of the penitential season leading up to Palm Sunday the beginning of Holy Week. Everyone is encouraged to attend daily Mass, receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attend the Stations of the Cross, engage in works of charity and justice, and undertake acts of self-denial.

The following are the guidelines of Lenten observance:

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.
- Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
- Fasting binds all persons who have completed their 18th birthday through those who have completed their 59th year, unless prevented by poor health.
- On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to one's own needs.
- Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.
- Abstinence binds all persons who have completed their 14th birthday, unless prevented by poor health. On days of abstinence, the consumption of meat is not allowed. The Church strongly encourages the observance of Friday abstinence, but failure to do so is not regarded as sinful.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION AT MASS

“The Communion Procession is an action of the Body of Christ. At Christ's invitation, extended by the priest acting in Christ's person: "Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb," the members of the community move forward to share in the sacred meal, to receive the Body and Blood of Christ which is the sign and the source of their unity. In fact, each time we move forward together to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord, we join the countless ranks of all the baptized who have gone before us, our loved ones, the canonized and uncanonized saints down through the ages, who at their time in history formed a part of this mighty stream of believers.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal directs that each country's Conference of Bishops determines the posture to be used for the reception of Communion and the act of reverence to be made by each person as he or she receives Communion. In the United States, the body of Bishops determined that Communion should be received standing, and that a bow is the act of reverence made by those receiving. These norms may require some adjustment on the part of those who have been used to other practices, however the significance of unity in posture and gesture as a symbol of our unity as members of the one body of Christ should be the governing factor in our own actions.

Those who receive Communion may receive either in the hand or on the tongue, and the decision should be that of the individual receiving, not of the person distributing Communion. If Communion is received in the hand, the hands should first of all be clean. If one is right handed the left hand should rest upon the right. The host will then be laid in the palm of the left hand and then taken by the right hand to the mouth. If one is left-handed this is reversed. It is not appropriate to reach out with the fingers and take the host from the person distributing.

The person distributing Communion says audibly to each person approaching, "The Body of Christ." This formula should not be altered, as it is a proclamation which calls for a response of faith on the part of the one who receives. The communicant should audibly respond, "Amen," indicating by that response his or her belief that this small wafer of bread, the wine in this chalice are in reality the body and blood of Christ the Lord. *The person receiving Communion should consume the Body of Christ immediately. No one is allowed to walk away with the host still in their hand. Or, to carry the consecrated host to another person.*

When one receives from the chalice, the same proclamation is made by the person distributing Communion and the Communicant again responds, "Amen." It should be noted that it is never permissible for a person to dip the host he or she has received into the chalice. If, for some reason, the communicant is not able or willing to drink from the cup then that person should receive only under the form of bread." *USCCB.*

As a sign of reverence and thanksgiving all receiving Holy Communion should never leave church immediately but return to their pew, kneel and reflect on Christ's presence within us and remain until the end of Mass. Those assigned to carry Holy Communion to the sick and home bound are required to present their pyx to the priest, deacon or acolyte after Mass and then go directly to the person waiting for their visit.

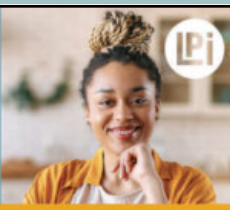

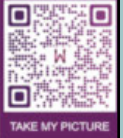
