An Easter Message from Father Wayne

Dear Parish Family,

Today, the Day of Resurrection hails in an ancient and familiar hymn; "Jesus Christ is Risen Today, Alleluia! Our triumphant holy day, Alleluia! Who did once upon the cross, Alleluia! Suffer to redeem our loss, Alleluia!" Indeed, the text of this popular and well-known hymn resounds in our hearts—we celebrate Christ Risen from the Dead, Alleluia!

As a Christian people and as a Community of Faith, we have much to be grateful for—as my mother often said to me as a child; "...we count our many blessings." It is my prayer that in this church, you will find a home—a spiritual home where heaven and earth meet, announcing the Glory of God and setting your hearts on fire with love, life, and service. I also welcome today those who are visitors to St. Michael the Archangel Parish. Perhaps this is your first visit, your visit with family and friends from out of town, or your annual visit—no matter how you come to join us today, we are glad that you are here and we invite you to join us for Mass every Sunday.

At the conclusion of our 9am and 11am Masses today, an Easter Egg Hunt will commence at our school football field. Donned in Easter bonnets and wearing our Sunday best, families will, I pray, take home with them memories that will last a lifetime. Memories that are much more than candies and sweets collected—memories made at Church and memories made with family, loved ones, and neighbors and strangers alike. For today, we are Truly, One in Christ! So as our age-old Easter hymn concludes, let our hearts and voices joyfully sing and proclaim Christ and the profundity of this feast each and every day as together we sing; "Sing we to our God above, Alleluia! Praise eternal as His love, Alleluia! Praise Him, now His might confess, Alleluia! Father, Son, and Spirit blest. Alleluia!"

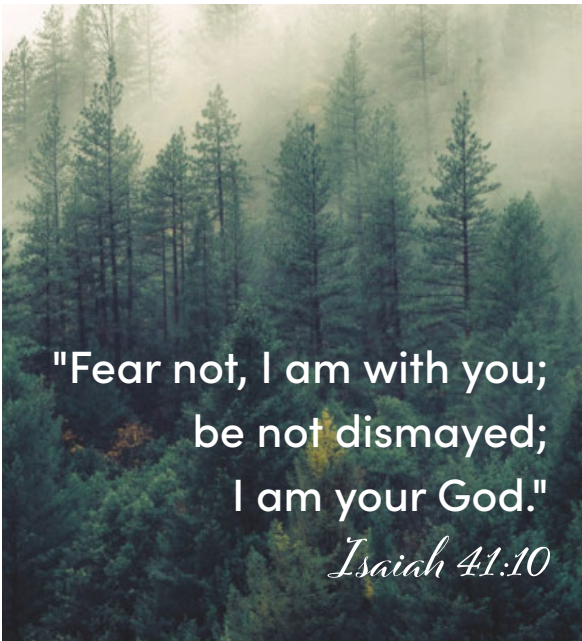

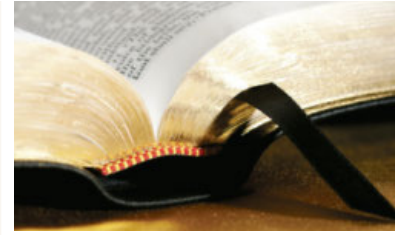

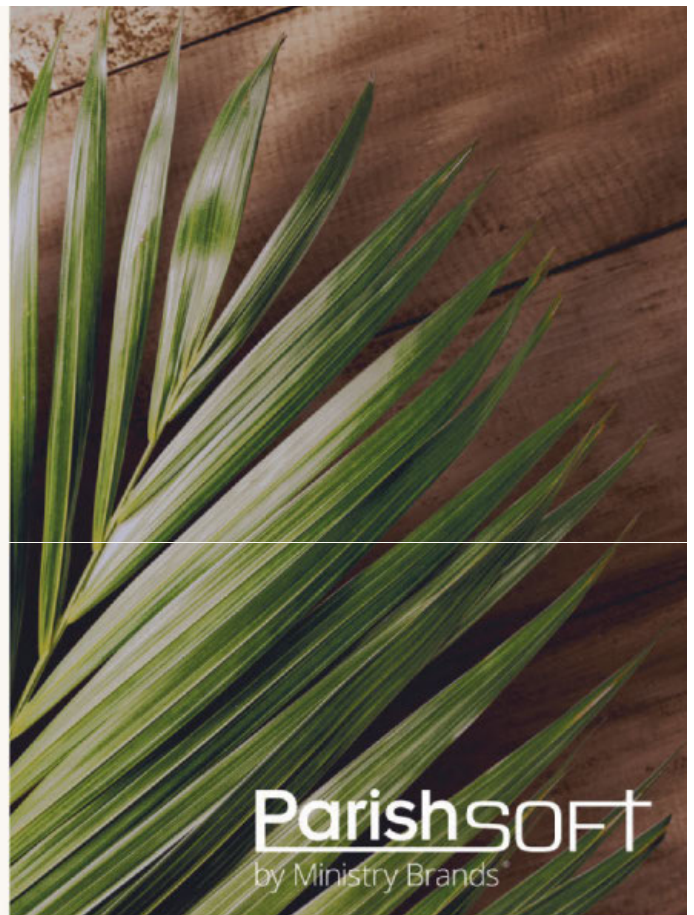
