Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Word made Flesh,

The mystery washing over us now is that God became one of us. It seems too weak to say that it encourages us, though it does...even as it shocks, confounds, and flabbergasts us. There's something about it that only poetry can begin to illuminate. The modern poet John Betjeman's poem "Christmas" concludes thus:

No love that in a family dwells,
No caroling in frosty air,
Nor all the steeple-shaking bells
Can with this single Truth compare—
That God was Man in Palestine
And lives to-day in Bread and Wine.

God has drawn unthinkable close to us in our own humanity and in the Great Sacrament of the Eucharist. In Jesus, we encounter One who is fully God and fully man. He feeds us with Himself in the Eucharist. This paradox always involves human things (family love, caroling, bells, bread and wine, etc) which are almost embarrassingly surpassed by the Divine Presence. Or, on the other hand, which seem to hide the divine presence and power. After all, there He is: a baby, crying, in a poor wandering loving family.

So we should allow the poetry of this Christmas season to attract our curiosity, to allow the paradox to become plausible. The feast of the Holy Family helps us consider more deeply the Christmas mystery, as will Epiphany and the Baptism of the Lord.

I'm grateful to everyone who participated in our Christmas Eve and Christmas Day celebrations, making them so beautiful. I'm particularly grateful for our hard-working little staff at the parish, and our priests and deacons. They work SO hard to make our parish run beautifully. Let's pray they enjoy some well-deserved rest. I'm also grateful to everyone who supports the parish with your prayer, service, and financial support. It all makes a huge difference, every little bit.

I pray that this Christmas Season may deepen our love for the great saving mystery which is God-made-man.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

Question:

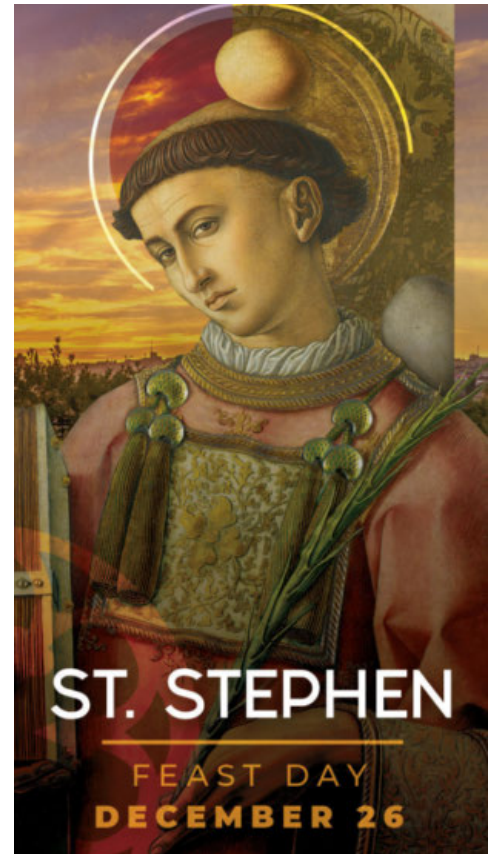

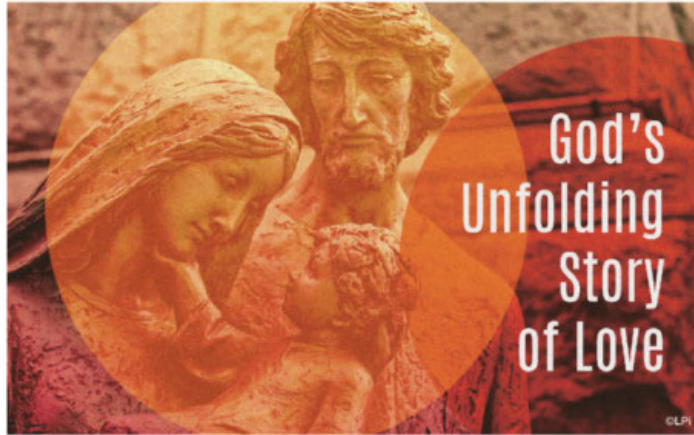

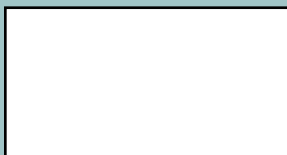
GOSPEL MEDITATION
Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Families can be very difficult things to negotiate. This is true not only of our families of origin, the current family of which we are a part, the family of our Church, our society, and our global family as well. Everything human can be found in family stories. Those stories speak of wonderful life-giving successes as well as painful spirit-robbing abuses. Our greatest joys and our greatest wounds are usually connected with the experience of family. Our needs, experiences, and unresolved baggage often color what we bring to our familiar relationships. They contribute to our level of defensiveness, how guarded and protected we become, and what prejudices we believe.

In order to break the cycle of dysfunction we have to remember that it is not only by human effort that we negotiate the difficult and challenging events of our lives. There is a Divine Effort at work as well. For sure, the human effort can create quite a mess and easily destroy lives. This is true of any family with which we are associated. Today's Feast of the Holy Family serves to help us understand that there is a Divine Story being told as well. It is a story of perseverance in the face of hardship, determination in the face of despair, healing when we see nothing but wounds, and light where there is darkness.

Do we believe that God is always working, guiding, restoring, and leading? Unless we do, we will never be free from the imperfections and wounds that bind us and never be able to understand what it really means to forgive. Pope Francis tells us that the "light which comes from the Holy Family encourages us to offer human warmth to other families." While this is most certainly true, we can only really begin to do this when we realize that we are still works in progress, not anchored to the wounds and sins of our past, and still a leading star in God's continually unfolding story of love. The Holy Family persevered and radiated warmth because they knew they were not alone. We can too.


