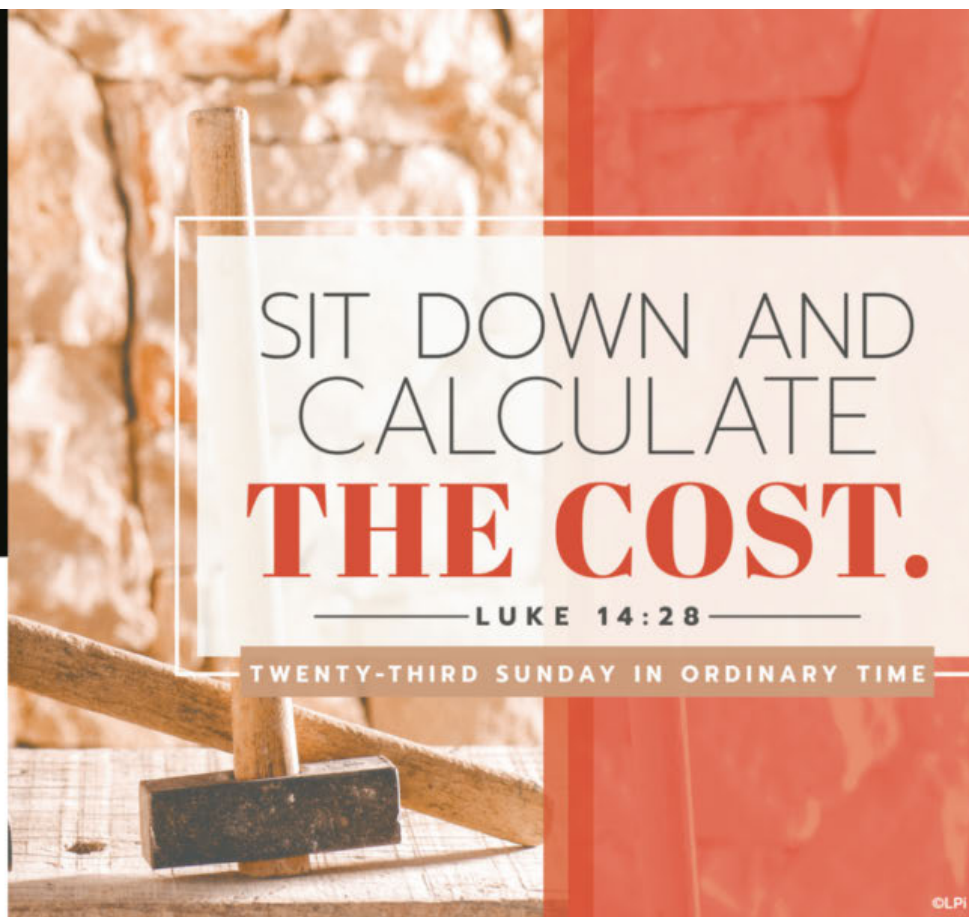

A TOUGH DECISION

A conversation that many of us clergy engage in with parishioners, friends, and those who are curious about the somewhat mysterious vocation of the priesthood is in relation to the number of priests or, more specifically, the perceived lack of men entering into the priesthood. It's a good observation and challenging conversation that has many possibilities of an answer, but in reality is quite complex. As vocations' director for the Diocese of Palmerston North in Aotearoa New Zealand, it was not an easy task to find young men who were interested in pursuing the priesthood and many reasons were given why they were choosing other career paths rather than discerning a vocation rather than an occupation. And perhaps that was part of the problem: many were looking at the priesthood not as vocation but as career.

This misconception, combined with worldly definition of success (money, status, power), combined with a societal decline in morals and values, smaller families (historically, larger families tended to produce more vocations as there were more males to carry on the family name), relativism and secularism, and even events and practices within our post-Vatican II Church (reduced emphasis on the sacraments, confused liturgies, diffusion of the role of altar servers which is a traditional role identified by seminarians where they first had a thought about being a priest) and scandals have all combined, with many other possibilities, to impact vocations. And perhaps one of the biggest obstacles is what Jesus is directly challenging all of his followers to embrace: God first, everything else second.

If a person were to prize something of great value and want to possess it, it's natural to ask what it will cost to "invest" in it. Jesus was utterly honest and spared no words to tell his disciples that it would cost them dearly to be his disciples. In fact, using the parables to make a point, it will cost someone their whole life and all they possess in exchange for the new life and treasure of God's kingdom. The Lord Jesus leaves no room for compromise or concession; either give our lives over to Him entirely or keep them for ourselves. But St. Paul reminds us "We are not our own. We were bought with a price" (1 Corinthians 6:19-20).

We were once slaves to sin and a kingdom of darkness and oppression, but we have now been purchased with the precious Blood of Jesus Christ who has ransomed us from a life of darkness and destruction so that we could enter His kingdom of light and truth. Christ has, however, set us free to choose whom we will serve in this present life – as well as in the age to come. The choice is as stark as Jesus' teaching: it is either God's kingdom of light, truth, and goodness or it is Satan's kingdom of darkness, lies, and deception. There are no neutral areas or parties – not even our families when it comes to selecting our God.
