## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I recently decided to learn to cook. As I sit at the feet of various YouTube cooking masters, I notice how much of cooking is adding ingredients that don't provide any more nourishment, like herbs and other seasonings. But man! They make all the difference because they make the meal delightful to eat and share.

Jesus calls his disciples “salt of the world.” No one eats just salt. So, Christians are not meant to replace or do away with the world. They are meant to be agents of preservation and glorification. Notice how often these days the Church seeks to preserve what is threatened: the goodness of marital and family love, the desires of young people for greatness, the value of honest work, healthy economics, and altruistic political engagement, the dignity of the poor and vulnerable. Over and over, we say to a world who wants to throw things out, “It’s worth saving! We’ll preserve it! We’ll show you it’s wonderful.” If we can’t engage the world like that, Jesus says we are the ones who get thrown out, because salt alone is worthless.

Jesus only asks us to do for others what he does for us. He is the “salt” of everything in our lives. Is there something in your life starting to rot a bit? Something tasting bland and boring? Let Jesus salt it and see if you like it better.

## EUCCHARISTIC PROCESSIONAL CANOPY

A Eucharistic Processional Canopy is carried above the Blessed Sacrament in a procession outdoors. The purpose of the canopy is both theological and practical: it emphasizes the kingship of Christ as His Eucharistic Body is honored in a manner similar to kings of old who were carried in procession on thrones. Further, it calls attention to His presence in a crowd, easily making noticeable where the Blessed Sacrament is located within a Eucharistic Procession. The practical purpose of the canopy is to protect the Blessed Sacrament from falling debris outdoors.

We wish to obtain this beautiful canopy embroidered with an image of the Holy Spirit for use in upcoming Eucharistic Processions we have planned, with our first use of the canopy hopefully coinciding with the Solemnity of Corpus Christi on June 11, the day in which the church celebrates and recalls the Catholic dogma of Jesus' True Presence of His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Blessed Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist.

The canopy and its accompanying equipment such as supporting poles will cost \$1,400. Please prayerfully consider a donation to fund this purchase to allow us to bring our Eucharistic Lord out into the neighborhood so we may better help our neighbors encounter the Light of the World.

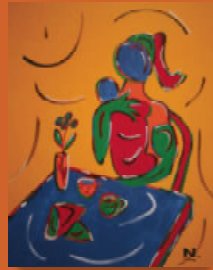
