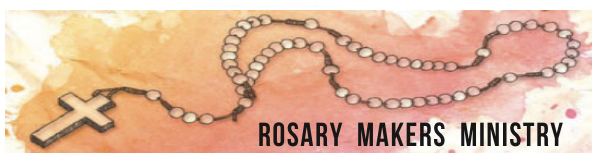

Other ways to be involved besides making rosaries include;

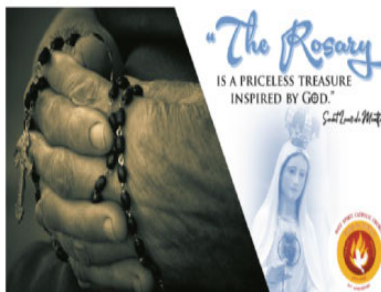
- Package supplies for rosary makers

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A protestant pastor friend of mine was invited to meet Pope Francis with a group of other pastors. He noticed the Pope's chair was especially ornate and set at the head of the group. He somewhat playfully said, "Holy Father, why do you get that special chair?" The group chuckled nervously at my friend's audacious chide.

The following year, the group was invited to return. They entered the room to find only simple chairs placed in a circle. Pope Francis entered, sat down in one of the humble chairs and, looking directly at my friend, with a twinkle in his eye, asked, "What do you think of my chair now?" My friend was stunned that the Pope remembered his concerns — and took the time to answer them.

Thomas the apostle was certainly stunned by the Risen Jesus displaying his wounds in person. But he also must have been equally shocked that Jesus knew and answered his particular questions, worries, and even demands related to his faith. How humbled — and perhaps a bit terrified — he must have been to realize God remembers his concerns and cares enough to answer them.

What questions or demands about Jesus do you find in your heart? Like Thomas, will you be bold enough to voice them this week? How wonderful to know that if we do so, God will remember and respond even to our most audacious desires.

OUR NEW BAPTISMAL FONT

Last weekend, our new baptismal font was blessed and immediately put to use, with 13 people from our OCIA group being baptized at the Easter Vigil, as well as the son of our Office Coordinator, Cynthia, being baptized at the 11am mass.



Over a year ago, the mechanical system of our former baptismal font, located near the sanctuary, broke and left us without a proper and functioning baptismal font. This incident caused us to reexamine the ongoing maintenance costs of the built-in font, which operated like a heated pool, coupled with an expensive repair that the system would require. Compared to the evolving needs of the parish, and considering how the layout of the font worked with the baptismal liturgies, it was determined a replacement was a better option than a repair.

The new location of the baptismal font, central to the axis of the church and just inside the entrance is symbolic of our journey of faith in the church. Both spiritually and physically, we enter the church at the baptismal font, and continue our journey to God by reconciling with him through confession, which is located along the sides of the church, before finally arriving at the altar. After being cleansed through these first sacraments, God can then enter us through the Holy Eucharist. Funerals too remind us of this, with the casket being blessed with holy water at the entrance, a reminder of the deceased's baptism, before being processed to the altar.





THE "BECOMING CATHOLIC" OCIA GROUP and four youth in the Sacramental Preparation program, received the three Sacraments of Initiation - Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion - at the Easter Vigil on March 30, 2024. In addition, eleven others received Confirmation and First Holy Communion.

New Christians enter into the history of salvation with baptism, previously baptized Christians are received into full communion with the Catholic Church, and all of those who have already been baptized renew their commitment and gratitude for their own baptism.

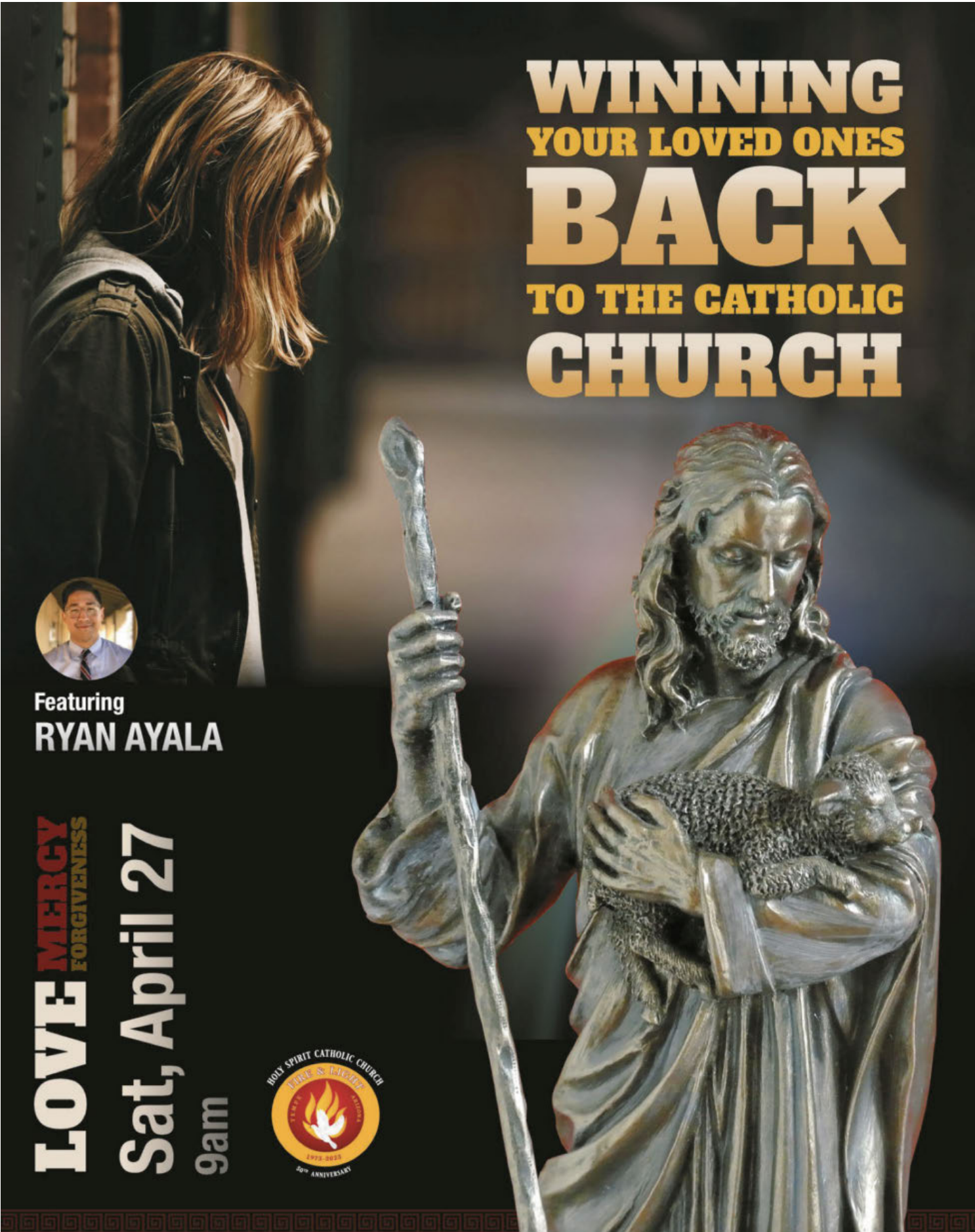
