Notes to First Six Months 2022 Financial Report:

- 1. Plate collections are not as strong as expected. Increase in online donations has helped offset in person donations.
- 2. Donations have been generous for maintenance (primarily replacing the sound system) including a single donation of \$10,000
- 3. Higher fundraising offset by lower CYO fees.
- 4. Higher facility use and votive candles.
- 5. Increased hours for staff.
- 6. Lower utilities and outside contractor costs.
- 7. Lower benefits.
- 8. Higher liturgy supplies.
- 9. Lower benefits and cantor costs.
- 10. Higher CYO and Dad's Club costs due to timing of events offset by delay in ministry expansion.
- 11. Timing of ministry fundraising events.

Church of the Assumption Statement of Activities January 31, 2022 - June 30, 2022

A critical aim of the Assumption Parish Finance Committee is to be as fully transparent as possible to the generous Assumption Parishioners. Below are highlights of the first six months of 2022.

Balance Sheet (not shown): As of June 30th, we appear to be in good shape with \$43,500 in the bank and total current liabilities of \$12,500. Fortunately, we have not had to draw down our savings in almost a year. However, a worrisome issue is our plate collections - in June they were down 1.8%, while July was up 1.1%, and August was up 3.8% from 2021. We have budgeted an increase of 11% in plate collections which is our goal going forward.

Some notes of interest for the initial six months of 2022 show our actual results versus budget: Revenues were higher by about \$8,000. This increase in revenues is primarily due to the success of the Maintenance drive in which we received \$20,000 more than expected. In addition, votive candle purchases and facility rentals added \$8,000. Offsetting somewhat these increases are the CYO and Dads' Club revenues which were lower by some \$3.000 due to timing. Mentioning again, the major concern is the shortfall of plate and EFT collections - down some \$17,000. This needs to be an everincreasing focus of all in the parish to jointly work together to bring the trend upward.

Overall, expenses were \$9,800 lower than budgeted. This is a real positive development as expenses are reviewed closely.

Taking all the above into account, the parish realized very good news even though the budget was projecting a loss of \$32,000, we were able to reduce it to \$14,000. Again though, keep in mind this is a bit misleading since more than \$20,000 of the donations are earmarked for the sound system whose implementation has been delayed due to supply chain issues.

In conclusion, we are moving steadily out of the COVID pandemic financial turmoil. Our financial picture is far more stable now. Our goal continues to be - move forward by increasing and enhancing existing and new ministries across the parish. To do this we need ever increasing support from our parishioners. Meeting our annual budgeted plate collections by 11% over last year will help immensely.

As always thank you for your generous support during the last year and thank you for the same going forward by possibly considering additional support towards our goal of growth.


