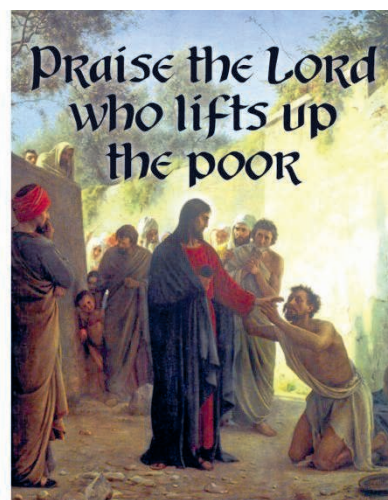

Come Celebrate with us!

We will have a special celebration of **San Lorenzo Ruiz** (the first formally acknowledged saint from the Philippines) on **September 22** at the 10:30 am mass at **St. George**. Fr. Scott has invited a close friend to come and speak at the mass that day. Dr. Kathleen McKain-Pitts is the older sister of **Molly McKain** who was the young woman officially declared the Miracle of St. Lorenzo by Saint Pope John Paul II in the 1980s. Molly had been in a horrible car accident as a young person and there was little hope for survival, but the prayers offered for her through the Filipino people through the intercession of St. Lorenzo brought about her recovery. After an in-depth investigation by the Vatican, it was determined that Molly's recovery was indeed a miracle which they attributed to San Lorenzo's prayers. Molly and Kathleen were able to meet St. John Paul II on the day of San Lorenzo's canonization, and Kathleen will be here at St. George to share more of the story. Come to celebrate with us and our Filipino community. There will be a reception afterward in the St. Francis Hall at St. George.

As many of you know, the Archbishop has decided to move the confirmation age down to Seventh Grade by the year 2021. **In anticipation of that move, we will be opening up Confirmation this year to all youth who are at least 14 years old or freshmen in high school.** Nina will be coming up with a schedule beginning in October, and we have decided to make it a full-fledged youth group program with Confirmation as one of the major aspects. We'd love to have as many of our High School youth involved as often as they can. We are looking at having the sessions on Sunday afternoons (probably from 2:30-4 pm). If you are a young adult or a parent who would like to help us as a team leader, please let us know and we will get you on-board. We could really use some help to get this wonderful program up and running. Please keep us in your prayers.
