or 3rd graders in First Communion preparation) every third Saturday of the month (9/18/21, 10/16/21, 11/20/21, 12/18/21, 1/15/22, 2/19/22, 3/19/22, 5/21/22, and 6/18/22) at 10 am at St. Edward. The parents will be given a parent book and one student book per child. The book in Year One is based on the Creed. It has 18 chapters (basically two per month) and we help the parents to share the faith with their children. The books are designed to work for all ages and have various activities to do as a family that are age appropriate.

Registration Fee: \$50.00/Child \$75.00/ Two or more children

**First Reconciliation and First Communion Preparation Information Form**

**First Communion** includes preparation for First Reconciliation. Parents and children will gather together every first Saturday of the month (10/2/21, 11/6/21, 12/4/21, 2/5/22, 3/5/22, 4/2/22, 5/7/22) at 10 am. We will celebrate our First Communions on the May 14/15, 2022 weekend at all the parishes during the weekend Masses. The plan is to share the teacher manual with each parent and they will teach their children the six lessons for First Reconciliation in the fall. The children will then sign up to go to receive their First Reconciliation at one of the regularly scheduled confession times or a Lenten Penance service. The parents will then be given another book with six chapters regarding First Holy Communion. After the sessions in February, March and April, the children will receive their First Communion at any one of the eight Masses in the four parishes on the weekend of May 14 & 15, 2022. **If your child is a baptized Catholic and in grade two or older you may want to consider the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion.**

There is a fee of \$100.00 to cover the materials for the program. This fee helps cover the cost of books, materials and other program-related fees, but if anyone has a problem covering the costs there are scholarships available. Please speak with the Office Coordinator if you need assistance or would like to set up a payment plan. We do not want anyone to refrain from the sacraments or from the preparation program due to financial difficulties.

You will need to provide a copy of your child's Baptismal certificate with this registration. All information on this form must be provided even if the child is living with just one parent.

**Confirmation Information Form**

**Confirmation** this year will be offered to all young people in **Seventh grade and older**. We will offer classes once a month on the fourth Sunday (9/26, 10/24, 11/28, 12/19, 1/23, 2/27, 3/27, 4/24, & 5/22) at 2:30 pm (right after the Spanish Mass) at St. Edward. In addition, the young people will be asked to attend a Confirmation Retreat (a one day for Middle Schoolers and a two day for High Schoolers). We don't know the dates of the two retreats yet, but will let you know as soon as we do. This program is meant for the young people only, but parents and sponsors will be asked to attend at least one session (most likely in the winter).

Registration Fee: \$150.00/Child This fee helps cover the cost of books, materials, a Confirmation Retreat and other program-related fees, but if anyone has a problem covering the costs there are scholarships available. Please speak with the Office Coordinator if you need assistance or would like to set up a

**Religious Education Programs this Fall**

Dear Parishioners



As you know, this weekend is our official Faith Formation Registration Weekend. Although we've been trying to register people starting this July, this is the official kick off as the new school year begins. We want people to get registered asap so that we

have the proper amount of books and materials for each of the four programs for our young people. Here is the basic breakdown of each program so you know what to sign up for.

**WFC stands for Whole Family Catechesis.**

Whole Family Catechesis is a new program this year offered to parents and children in grades K-6 (although not 2nd

### Information Form for RCIA for Children

The **Children's Catechumenate** (also called RCIA for children) is a year-round process of preparation for children seven years old and older who are not baptized. The church believes that **when children reach the "age of reason" at seven, they are capable of making the decision to be baptized themselves.** Therefore, the church offers this educational and formative process to help them on that journey. We will be offering classes every other Sunday during the school year (maybe a couple times next summer) and throughout the coming year to prepare them to be fully initiated (Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion) at the Easter Vigil in 2023.

Registration Fee: \$100.00/Child (for a two year program)

This fee helps cover the cost of books, materials and other program-related fees, but if anyone has a problem covering the costs there are scholarships available. Please speak with the Office Coordinator if you need assistance or would like to set up a payment plan. We do not want anyone to refrain from the sacraments or from the preparation program due to financial difficulties.

You will need to provide a copy of your child's Birth certificate with this registration.
