
Sunday Readings

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Adult inquiry Classes began 9/23 at St. **Edwards**

The Children's Catechumenate (RCIA for **children**) is a year-round preparation process for children seven years and older who are not baptized. When children reach the "age of reason" at seven, the Church believes they are capable of making the decision to be baptized for themselves.

First Communion and **First Reconciliation**

Parents and children will gather together every first Saturdays at 10am. Follow-up meetings will be on the third Sundays at 9:30 in the respective parishes.

First Communion celebration will be May 14th and 15th during weekend Masses at all parishes.

Synodal Process

We invite all of our parishioners to join our universal Church in a global listening process Pope Francis has called us to: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission". In October 2023, Bishops will meet at the Vatican to discuss how the Church listens and consults. We are called to participate in this two-year reflection process by participating in a diocesan listening phase where we can share our thoughts on how the Church listens and engages with us.

Please join us on Saturday, March 12th at St. Paul from 10:00 am to 12 pm for a conversation facilitated by leaders from our Pastoral Council. This is an important opportunity for all of our parishioners at the South Seattle Cluster to attend. During this day, we will be able to share how we have seen the Church listen (or not listen) to us, the gifts of the Church, and the struggles we have faced together.

As you discern your participation, pray on the words Pope Francis spoke as he opened this Synod in October, "Let us ask: in the church, are we good at listening? How good is the hearing of our heart? Do we allow people to express themselves, to walk in faith even though they have had difficulties in life, and to be part of the life of the community without being hindered, rejected or judged?"

Please join us on March 12th.We hope you can participate in this opportunity to join our universal Church in a prayerful and transformational experience.
