

As a parish, we will be "hosting" monthly. Hosting requires 4 volunteers to go to the Bitter Lake Community Center to help set up and serve the meals. No cooking and cleaning is requiring. We'd like to have a pool of volunteers, so you would volunteer every 2-3 months.
