

Pastor's Letter

Dear Parishioners.

We had a blessed month of July with many changes. We miss Father Martin, who was our formal Pastor at Visitation, and he is now the new Pastor at pro-cathedral of Saint James' Church in Vancouver. We are still waiting for the arrival of Father Hendry, our Parochial Vicar of St. Ann, St. John of the Woods, and Visitation Churches. We had Father Mike Williams who was with us for the month of July, and he just left us last Sunday to return to the university for his ministry as a professor. We are working with Father Jose, who is assisting Father Patrick and me during this month of August and I hope that Father Hendry will arrive soon to take up his duties and role that Archbishop had assigned to him. We thank Father Patrick for his help and support, as well as our two Deacons Michael Teskey and Theman Pham together with the Sisters of the Lovers of the Holy Cross of Go-Vap for helping us during this transition time.

We had many different meetings throughout the summer with different subcommittees from the Strategy Planning for the merging of our parishes. I thank the subcommittee members for their commitment to assisting us to gather information from different areas. This subcommittee meets and gives us their recommendation, so I am following up with their recommendations on how we can implement various strategies in the areas of Faith Formation, Communication, Facility, Diversity, Catholic School, Ministry, Liturgy, and in the areas of Finance and Stewardship. I am still waiting for other subcommittees, who are still working on their report and once they have completed this, they will present it to me. I spend time analyzing their information and have asked the Communication Committee to share this information with you. I thank you for being so compassionate and supportive of this process that we are faithfully going through. Now, it is the time for us to share with you about our plan and the steps that we are taking to implement it.

We have a parishes' joint bulletin for this weekend in which we have combined information from each parish to make it easy for our parishioners to obtain information they need in one place. We have done this before, and we have obtained experience in how to do this efficiently now. We thank the parish staff and parish leadership teams who assist us, and we thank you for your support. We are taking a small step and are currently obtaining Holy Rosary Parish's list to assist the Outreach Committee to assist us to reach out to our parishioners. We are working on a survey that we wish to send out to our parishioners to ask them for information on how we can reach out to them, how we can support them, and we also would like them to engage with our parish after the pandemic. We are forming the New Parish Leadership Team, who has the gift of vision and priority for our parish's mission. As leaders, we need to have a "Vision" for the future, and we can do this by setting priorities making our dream parish a reality (a parish that can serve us with our needs soon).

We congratulate those parents who joined us to celebrate their children's Baptism and we also congratulate those couples who made their vows to be faithful with each other for their vocation of family life. We are very happy to welcome you back to different parish programs that you have signed up to volunteer to assist in various ministries and events that we are planning to have for the coming year.

Archbishop has appointed both Deacons Michael Teskey and Theman Pham to serve us. Deacon Theman Pham is serving at St. Ann's Church and Deacon Michael Teskey is at Visitation Church as per their Ministry Agreement with me. We thank them for their generous time and talent in serving our parishes in this ministry. I have asked our Communication Team to share this Good News and post on the parishes' bulletin and website their assignment as well as their decree, so you can thank God and thank them for their ministry among us. We welcome students, who are joining us for summer school. They are happy to learn and play in-person with their friends and to pray for their parents each day. We thank their parents who enrolled them to our parish's summer program, and we thank their teachers for their commitment to assist our students with this wonderful summer program.

We would like to ask you to let us know if you want to receive the Sacrament of Anointing and bring holy communion to your home. We are asking and seeking more volunteers to support different programs and ministries. We thank the leadership group from the Vietnamese Catholic Community at St. Ann's Church for coming to their meeting. I thank them for their commitment in this ministry and I am amazed with their programs, which is all led by volunteers. We have a very strong youth program, and they are slowly getting back to their in-person meetings. 

WASHINGTON—Pope Francis has accepted the resignation of Bishop Randolph R. Calvo from the pastoral governance of the Diocese of Reno and has appointed Bishop Daniel H. Mueggenborg, auxiliary bishop of Seattle, as Bishop of Reno. The appointment was publicized in Washington, D.C. on July 20, 2021, by Archbishop Christophe Pierre, apostolic nuncio to the United States.

The Diocese of Reno is comprised of 70,852 square miles in the State of Nevada and has a total population of 734,093 of which 89,838 are Catholic.

St. Dominic

Saint Dominic was born in Caleruega, Spain in 1170. His parents were members of the Spanish nobility and related to the ruling family. His father was Felix Guzman, and was the royal warden of the village. His mother, Bl. Joan of Aza, was a holy woman in her own right.



It is known that Dominic was educated in Palencia, and he concentrated on theology and the arts. He spent six years studying theology and four the arts. He was widely acclaimed as an exemplary student by his professors. In 1191, a famine left many people desolate and homeless across Spain. Dominic sold everything he had, including his furniture and clothes and bought food for the poor. When he sold his manuscripts, required for study, he replied, "Would you have me study from these dead skins when people are dying of hunger?"
