Dear beloved brothers and sisters,

We had a blessed celebration last Sunday for the Lunar New Year (Tet). It was a blessed weekend with many people joining us for New Year's Eve and New Year's Day events. We also had a blessed Convocation at Tacoma Convention Center for the Partners in the Gospel event. We received the material and information from this event and have posted them on our parish website and parish weekly newsletter, so you know what is happening. We are entering the Fourth Weekend of Ordinary Time with many different celebrations within our Parish of Pope Saint John XXIII. We had a gathering with the Parish Staff and Leadership Team members to follow up with our journey that we had started on December 10^{th,} and we had smaller groups continually meet and we gather on Saturday to share what we had been hearing from each other! We thank you for taking your time to listen to each other and allowing the Holy Spirit to guide us on encountering and accompanying each other on the Journey of sharing the Good News from the Gospel!

As I had mentioned to you in my last weekend's letter that we had many different meetings, so we can listen and understand each other, and we are able to find the way to work with each other on the issue and concern that we have. I thank you for taking time to join our parish on the leadership team as well as joining us in different ministries and activities that we have. We celebrated the life of our long-time parishioners, and we thank you for coming to attend their Funeral Masses. Their families deeply appreciated you for your love and care, especially your presence and prayers for them. It is hard for us to lose our faithful parishioners, who have been so faithful to their Faith and support our parish's mission. When they were young that they encountered, accompanied us on the journey of their Faith, and they witnessed the Living Gospel and when they were unable to support us with participation and involvement in our parish's activities, we had reached out to them by visiting them. We had a wonderful week to celebrate the Lunar New Year and we had a beautiful day to talk about Vocation. On Monday our Catholic School invited guests to different classrooms to talk about different vocations such as marriage, religious order in their community, and about the priesthood in parish life. There are many different vocations, and we need time to pray and discern, which will allow us to decide what is the right path for our lives. Our parish had been housing/hosting many formal Seminarians during their Formation for the Priesthood. They are still contacting us and thanking us for supporting them during their Formation. We thank you for continually pray for Vocation and we thank you for supporting us as well.

We thank our parish's Liturgy Committee as well as the Commission members who assist us with visions and priorities for the Liturgical events happening within our parish's locations that we are planning to have. We must plan and prepare for these Liturgical events, as you know, this takes a lot of work and time to prepare for them. We are very blessed to have the Liturgy members to assist our parish. We will celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord, when we traditionally bless Candles and we also planned to celebrate the Feast of Saint Blaise with the blessing of the Throat and of all illness (disease and sickness). Pope Francis called upon leaders of different denominations for a big celebration on Sunday to pray for each other. We thank you for gathering with us to pray at our merging parish as well!

We thank the core team who assists us with this program, and we also thank members who are joining us. We thank you for praying for them and I introduced them at the Rite of Welcoming, Accepting, and we will send them to the Rite of Election when the Lenten Journey begins! We are very blessed to have a strong Faith Formation Program within our Parish of Pope Saint John XXIII. We have been working together with different sites and locations and it is hard for us to have volunteers to have this program. We have been consultation with each other on how to best share the resources within our Parish of Pope Saint John XXIII. It is hard in starting this, but we need to be patient and learn from each other, so we can build a strong parish.

We had a blessed first month for the New Year of 2023. We thank you for encountering within our parish by registering your family into our Pope Saint John XXIII Parish. You are also cordially invited to join us on the leadership team and assist our parish with what you can do. The parish is always there to support your family. We also have the program for young families. We cordially invite you to join our Catholic School for a week in promoting our Catholic School. 


