Pastor's Letter

Dear beloved brothers and sisters,

We had a blessed weekend with many different events at our parish. We thank our speakers who shared with us the information on Partners in the Gospel initiative that we are going to have with all the parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Seattle. I hope that you like the Video, and the information that we had posted on our parish's website. I encourage you to use the prayer card to pray for the success of the program. We had a blessed gathering for our parish's leadership retreat at Saint John of the Woods Mission's location. I thank our Parish Leadership Team members who came for these important gathering to pray for our parish and to have time to listen to each other to envision our parish's planning. The parish leadership members gathered to study the information of our parish's facility and property at each site of our parish, especially the Holy Rosary's facility. I thank the Financial and Pastoral Councils' members who shared with me their recommendations. We are entering the Fifth Week of the Liturgical celebration in Ordinary Time. We had a blessed week for Christian Unity prayers, and we thank you for joining us for this event. We also had a prayerful week to pray for our Catholic School. The students from Pope Saint John XXIII STEM Academy shared with us the Good News during the Catholic School Week and we also spent the whole week to pray for the legal protection for unborn children. We had been very busy for the whole month of January, since we had started the New Year. We thank you for participating in the Vietnamese New Year, even though, we were so busy with many other tasks and projects, but we were able to gather to celebrate the Lunar New Year with different celebrations throughout the week.

We thank our Parish Leadership Team members on the Financial and Pastoral Councils for their regular meeting last Wednesday as well as the separate meeting with representatives at Saint John of the Woods Mission, who spent their own time to meet with me to go through written reports from different organizations, commissions, committees, and groups. We thank you for engaging and involving with our parish's ministry as well as parish's activities at each site and locations.

We thank you for taking time to attend the Funeral Mass and Services at our main parish's site and at other parish's sites and locations. We had more Funerals after Christmas and the New Year at our parish, for our elderly parishioners, and we were able to reach out to the formal parishioners to celebrate their lives, as well as reaching out to them during their time that they needed us. We thank you for taking time to join us to reach out to care for them by calling them or sending them a post card to let them know that we pray for them. I had been encouraging you to register your family to our parish, so we can have the accurate information that we need. I spent most of my time consulting with the parish's leadership to envision as well as providing clear vision and priorities for our parish. We welcomed Jesse Torre, who is overseeing and managing the facility and is the custodian of our parish. We thank the Facility Committee who met and welcomed him, we thank Don who gave him the orientation and showed him around our campus, and assisted him with some directions on how to prioritize the projects that we are able to take up so we are able to work with volunteers or projects that we need to hire a professional to take care of the task (if we have sufficient financial resources), for example fitting/fixing our elevator. We have the Archdiocese's inspection for our parish's property and facilities at each location of our parish. We just got the insurance inspection, and they recommended us to look into some areas regarding the issue of safety. We need to update certain areas such as the rails for some stairwells, doors, and other places to prevent accidents. The Safety and Environment, the Maintenance and the Facility Committees of our parish will look at these areas and will take care of them. We thank them for their support of our parish!

We thank you for supporting and praying for our Candidates and members who are enquiring in the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults and Children. They joined us when we celebrated the Rite of Welcoming and Accepting them into the program. We gathered with them to celebrate the Rite of Sending them to meet with the Archbishop and Bishop to enroll their names in the Book of the Elect. They are on their discernment process of joining us for Full Communion with the Catholic Faith or joining us with the Sacrament of Initiation at the Easter Vigil with our Faith Community and their families.

We have a wonderful program for our Faith Formation at Pope Saint John XXIII Parish. We thank our volunteers of our program, and we thank Sister Theresa who is Coordinator and Director of this program. She is a blessed and wonderful support for our volunteers who assist us with the Religious Education, Confirmation, Baptism, RCIA, Bible Study, and the Youth and Adult programs. We welcome all the babies who joined us through the Sacrament of Baptism. We thank their parents and godparents who took the Baptism Class to prepare themselves well before they took their child to the Church to receive the Sacrament of Baptism. It is through this Sacrament that our Faith Community welcome our Newly Baptized to our Faith Community.


