

Pastor's Letter

I welcomed many people who came for Ash Wednesday's celebration, and those that came to the Rite of Election with our Elects and Candidates. You are also welcome to join us for the first weekend of our Lenten Journey. We thank the Coordinator on the Communication Committee who had spent time to organize the information of our parish's sites and to share with us all different activities during these Forty Days of our Lenten Journey. This information will assist you to choose events and activities that you can assist and participate in. We have the Stations of the Cross on Friday at different days for the for the Soup Meal (supper) during Lent. We also have different days for thereats and Day of Reflection to support different ministry groups and smaller Faith Community. We welcome all the Youth Leadership Team members from the Eucharistic Youth Group who have their retreat gathering for this weekend to prepare for their election to select a new leadership team for the coming term).

We thank the Coordinator of our Faith Formation Program, Sister Theresa for organizing the meeting with parents and their children to meet with me. This meeting is important, so I can share with the parents the report of their children's progress in the program, and they also can witness and observe me interview their child on what they have been learning from the Faith Formation Program. We also thank the core team who organize the Children's Mass and we cordially invite you to join us on this day.

We congratulated all the babies and children who received the Sacrament of Baptism last week and this weekend. We thank Deacon Theman and the Baptism Team, who assisted us to prepare parents and godparents to take up this responsibility to support the newly baptized member. We also thank our Faith Community for continuing to support them by praying for them.

We thank our Parish Staff and volunteers for their precious time to help clean our Church. Obligation during Lent

<u>Abstinence</u>

abstinence is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.

Fasting

In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years (inclusive) on ash Wednesday and good Friday, one full meal is allowed.


