Pastor's Letter

Dear Parishioners,

We had a blessed Divine Mercy Sunday celebration at Pope Saint John XXIII Parish and Saint John of the Woods Mission! We thank the core team members who assisted us in organizing this event for our parish. It was a prayerful procession of the Blessed Sacrament, after the Second Sunday Mass for the Divine Mercy. We thank you for your devotion and response to this celebration to honor the Divine Mercy event within our Parish Family. We also gathered to celebrate the dedication of the Church of Saint Rita of Cascia, to remember the date when this Church was built. She was faithful to serve many families who came to this holy place, and we thank former parishioners of this Faith Community for joining us on this special day to pray for their members. May the Lord continue to bless upon us! We also thank the core team members from Saint Rita's Station Church who sponsored The Shroud of Turin Traveling Exhibit, displayed at our parish during Holy Week, and we had many parishioners who came to pray in front of this Exhibit. I am working with the core team members at Saint Rita's Station to plan for the celebration of her Feast Day in May. When I know more information, I will share it with you!

We thank the Financial and Pastoral Councils who gathered for their regular meeting during Holy Week. It is important for me to consult with our leadership on issues and concerns of our parish. They are very important to me in my leadership, providing consultation on all different matters relating to our Parish Family. We thank the Financial Council for their time in preparing the budget for the coming year. We had a difficult time creating the budget document for the coming year, because we are not sure of the income and there are many expenses that we must pay, which is coming up and we are not able to predict the amount. There are many unknown things that we must do during this transition. We thank you for joining us to pray for the Partner in the Gospel's planning for our Parish Family, to allow us to open our hearts to listen to the Gospel and we can share the Good News of Christ with those we meet each day. We can ask ourselves this question: How can we join to support the ministry of our Parish Family, so we can reach out to touch more lives?

It was a joy for our Parish family to witness the Baptism that we celebrated with the family who shared with us the new life through this sacrament. It was a wonderful event for me to baptize the child and newborn as well as to celebrate the Sacrament of Initiation with those new members at the Easter Vigil this year. I thank you for your prayerful support of them and making them feel welcomed to our Faith Community. We thank the RCIA Team members who spent the whole year with them on their journey and you are continuing to pray for them as new members to our Parish Family. I also congratulate all the students who received the sacrament of their First Reconciliation, and they are planning for their First Holy Communion with us. You are cordially invited to join them and their families for this sacrament. I am very proud of each one of them and I also thank their parents for their commitment to their time and sacrifice for their children. They showed true love and care for their children. We thank parents who have been trying to set a wonderful example of the if faith in teaching their children. It was a joy for our parish to support them and their children to receive the sacrament. We also thank our parish volunteers who gave themselves in serving our parish with different ministries. Because of you, our Parish Family is alive and vibrant! We are entering the Third Week of the Easter Season and hear the story of the new Christian Community experiencing so much joy, united and sharing what they had to support those who did not have enough or had nothing. 
